CHILD & TEEN CHECKUP OUTREACH AND ASSISTANCE

Child and Teen Checkups (C&TC) works to increase awareness for parents of children who are eligible to have well child exams and routine medical care.

DISEASE PREVENTION & CONTROL

- Public immunization clinics
- Annual seasonal flu clinics, on site and at area worksites
- Education related to vaccine preventable diseases and communicable diseases
- Infectious disease investigations
- Services and outreach to immigrants and refugees new to our community
- Home Based services to persons of all ages with Asthma
- Healthy Homes Grant-home safety assessment/teaching

FAMILY HOME VISITING

*Evidence-based Curriculum
"Growing Great Kids"*

Home visits for prenatal women and parents who have children under age 3 who need or would like help and support for parenting, health and developmental guidance

HEALTH PROMOTION AND EDUCATION

- Statewide Health Improvement Partnership (SHIP) works in the community to support partners who want to make changes that would affect the health of our community.
- Drug Free Communities Coalition (DFC) works with youth in the schools and community to promote tobacco, drug and alcohol free living. Also works with partners to address Opioid use in our community

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Local activity around planning and preparing for response to disasters, such as infectious disease outbreaks, severe weather, natural disasters, incidents resulting in mass casualties, and acts of bioterrorism.

CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY

- Education and child passenger safety seat checks for ALL families.
- Distribution of car seats based on eligibility
- Community training and clinics

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

Registered Sanitarians provide:

- Inspection and licensing of area food, pool, and lodging establishments; mobile home parks; recreational camping areas; and tobacco retailers
- Education and information related to food safety, water quality, and clean air
- Investigation and follow up on public health nuisance complaints
- FREE Radon test Kits

WIC & BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT

- Nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and healthy foods through e-WIC cards used for purchases at local retailers.
- Children birth to age 5 and women who are pregnant, breastfeeding or new mothers are eligible based on income and nutritional need.
