

ORDINANCE NO. 1932

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LYONS, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2015, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1920.**

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lyons, Kansas:

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Lyons, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2015, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Lyons, Kansas, by Ordinance No. \_\_\_\_\_" with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. OMITTING PROVISIONS FROM THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. The following sections are hereby omitted and deleted from the Uniform Public Offense Code:

3.7; 6.7.1; 6.19; 11.8; 11.9; 11.10

Section 3. REPEAL OF EXISTING ORDINANCES. Ordinance Number 1920 dated 18 August 2014 of the City of Lyons, Kansas are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the Lyons News, the official newspaper of the City of Lyons, Kansas.
