

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions
May 4, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 239 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 161.01(Vacations) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 262 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Southeastern Equipment Company, Inc., of Marietta, Ohio, for the sale/trade-in of a backhoe currently in use by the Wastewater Treatment Department which has become obsolete, not needed, or unfit for public use, with a trade-in value of \$20,000.00; and for the purchase of a new backhoe model 2023 KOBELCO SK55SRX-7 with standard warranty for use by the Wastewater Treatment Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost of \$76,696.00, for the total acquisition price, including trade-in, not to exceed \$56,696.00 in a single contract, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(B), under the auspices of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act, as administered by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 263 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 264 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to allocate and/or set aside a portion of monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund, (ARPA) to be used for Slum, Blight, and Nuisance Remediation (Code Enforcement) by the Department of Property Maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 267 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 245 (22-23), passed April 6, 2023, which authorized and directed the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into contracts with three (3) different companies for the Marietta City Garage Upgrade Project, to-wit: Morrison, Inc. for heating and air conditioning; R. W. Miller Plumbing & Electric, Inc. for remodel of bathroom; and Eco Shine Polishing, Inc., for floor resurfacing, because the amount to be paid to each contractor in Ordinance No. 245 (22-23) did not factor in prevailing wage amounts. Now, after factoring in prevailing wage amounts, Morrison, Inc. shall be paid a sum not to exceed \$12,105.14; R. W. Miller Plumbing & Electric, Inc. shall be paid a sum not to exceed \$17,870.00; and Eco Shine Polishing, Inc. shall be paid a sum not to exceed \$9,300.00, for a grand total amount not to exceed \$39,275.14; using American Rescue Plan Act Funds, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 268 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into a contract with J. Miller Construction of Macksburg, Ohio for the Oak Grove Cemetery Storage Building Project, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00; using American Rescue Plan Act Funds, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 94 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the filing of the 2023 Community Development Block Grant Program Action Plan for the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 95 (22-23)** A Resolution by the City of Marietta, Ohio, in the matter of the approval of the Solid Waste Management Plan (2023-2037) for the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

May 18, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 255 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Professional Services Contract with the Southeastern Ohio Port Authority (SeOPA) to assist the City of Marietta's Development Department with economic development matters for the period from June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2024, at a cost not to exceed \$30,000.00.
- **Ordinance No. 266 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to temporarily suspend the operation of DORA (Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area) during the Marietta Riverfront Roar, for the date of Saturday July 8, 2023.
- **Ordinance No. 269 (22-23)** An Ordinance to declare the existence of a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and its municipal utility, the Water Department, as a result of needed inventory of materials, and perhaps replacement of some of Marietta's water lines, to ensure that any lead piping that may be located within said water mains can be replaced, so as to prevent an unhealthy condition that could detrimentally affect the citizens of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and therefore, to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract or contracts without formal bidding, advertising, and quality based selection, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 735.051 and 153.71(B), for the Marietta Lead Service Lines Investigations, Design and Construction Project at a price not to exceed \$400,000.00 and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 270 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Resolution No. 99 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize Jordana Bungard of West Side Sign Company, to install, under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service, artwork created by artist, Alaina Pellett, upon the existing traffic control/electric box located near the corner of Fifth and Washington Streets, with said project being sponsored by Marietta Main Street, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 100 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Mayor, or the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio, to apply for, accept, and enter into a Cooperative Loan Agreement on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA), through the Ohio EPA Drinking Water Assistance Fund (DWAF), for a principal forgiveness loan which will be administered through a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (SWRLA), with said loan needed immediately in order to secure lead service line investigations, so as to ensure safe drinking water, and due to the present emergency, to waive the second and third readings of said Resolution and to pass said Resolution on its first reading, because the City has been approved for a principal forgiveness loan in an amount not to exceed, \$400,000.00, however, legislation must be passed on or before May 18, 2023, so the loan application can be submitted by the May 19, 2023 deadline, thus declaring an EMERGENCY.
