

ORDINANCE NO. 178 (22-23)

An Ordinance to abolish the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109 that was created by Ordinance No. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED; and furthermore, to amend the City of Marietta, Ohio's current Table of Organization to reflect the abolishment of said position; and to repeal Ordinance No. 292 (20-21) in its entirety, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2021, the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio, passed Ordinance No. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED, created the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109 in the Wastewater Department, and further designated the duties of said position, and established the salary and benefits thereof; and

WHEREAS, currently there is no person working in the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109 in the Wastewater Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta wishes to abolish the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta wishes to amend the City of Marietta, Ohio's current Table of Organization to reflect the abolishment of said position; and


WHEREAS, the City of Marietta wishes to repeal Ordinance No. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED, in its entirety; now therefor

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


- Section 1: That the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109 that was created by Ordinance N. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED, is hereby abolished.
- Section 2: That the City of Marietta's current Table of Organization is hereby amended to reflect the abolishment of the position of Wastewater Operator/Maintenance Technician 105/109.
- Section 3: That Ordinance No. 292 (20-21), AS AMENDED, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and

for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order to provide for the restructuring of positions and duties in the Wastewater Department, to enable said Department to more efficiently fulfill its responsibilities. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


