

ORDINANCE NO. 193 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids for the anticipated purchase of various street construction materials for use by the Public Works Department (formerly the Street Department) of the City of Marietta, Ohio, during the coming construction season, calendar year 2023, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (formerly known as the Street Department) of the City of Marietta, Ohio, will be engaged in the annual repair of City streets during the construction season for the year 2023; and,

WHEREAS, firm commitments in the form of bids for the price of various street construction materials to be used during those repairs are essential for the calculation of the cost of each such repair, without obtaining individual quotes repeatedly; and,


WHEREAS, the maintenance of a system of firm bids for various street construction materials will otherwise improve the operation and efficiency of the Public Works Department (formerly Street Department) of the City of Marietta, Ohio; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the anticipated purchase of various street construction materials for use by the Public Works Department (formerly known as the Street Department) of the City of Marietta, Ohio, during the construction season for the year 2023, according to the plans and specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that materials need to be in place for the 2023 construction schedule; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
