

ORDINANCE NO. 198 (22-23)

An Ordinance to amend the Salary Step Schedule of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to temporarily increase the salary, for the position of the Water Superintendent at the Water Treatment Plant, from February 1, 2023 through February 6, 2024, and declaring an EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

- Section 1: That the Salary Step Schedule of the City of Marietta, Ohio, shall be and is hereby amended to temporarily increase the salary for the Water Superintendent at the Water Treatment Plant, from February 1, 2023 through February 6, 2024, as more fully set forth on the Salary Step Schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which salary rate and terms and conditions are hereby adopted and approved.
- Section 2: That the existing Salary Step Schedule established by Ordinance No. 155 (22-23) passed On November 17, 2022, shall be and is hereby repealed, only as to the portion concerning the salary of the Water Superintendent at the Water Treatment Plant. All other portions of the Salary Step Schedule that was passed by Ordinance No. 155 (22-23) shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 3: That the Auditor shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay the Water Superintendent at the Water Treatment Plant, the sum due to him, as shown in Exhibit A, with said sum being payable from February 1, 2023 through February 6, 2024.
- Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary because the City is required to have the Water Treatment Plant staffed by someone who holds a Class III Operator's License. The current Water Superintendent, who wished to retire on February 3, 2023, has agreed to remain in the position of Water Superintendent through February 6, 2024, to allow the City of Marietta adequate time to find a replacement, and the City has agreed to compensate the current Water Superintendent for agreeing to remain in his current position until the City can secure a replacement. WHEREFORE, this



Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


