

ORDNANCE NO. 207 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc. of Marietta, Ohio, for the purchase of one (1) Compact Track Loader/Skid Steer for use by the Wastewater Treatment Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost not to exceed \$65,750.92 under the auspices of the Cooperative Purchasing Program, administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01 (B), and an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a need exists for the City of Marietta, Ohio to purchase one (1) Compact Track Loader/Skid Steer, for use in the Wastewater Treatment Department; and,

WHEREAS, following an analysis of the city's needs in this respect, and the alternatives available for the provision of those needs, the Director of Public Safety and Service has recommended that the City enter into a contract with Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc., of 26580 State Route 7, Marietta, Ohio, 45750, for the purchase of one (1) Case TR270B, Diesel 4- stroke, Turbo, D.1., Compact Track Loader/Skid steer, Model FPT F5H FL463 A*GOOI, for use by the Wastewater Treatment Department, of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a total cost not to exceed \$65,750.92; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 1995, via passage of Resolution No. 75 (94-95); and via passage of Resolution No. 3 (22-23) on February 7, 2022; the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio approved the City's voluntary participation in the use of State contracts (based upon State public bids) which the Ohio Department of Transportation has entered into, for the acquisition of certain machinery, materials, supplies and other articles, including Compact Track Loaders/Skid Steers; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety and Service has determined that the Compact Tract Loader/Skid Steer required by the City of Marietta, Ohio is listed within the Ohio Department of Transportation's Cooperative Purchasing Contract; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of (1) Case TR270B, Diesel 4- stroke, Turbo, D.I., Compact Track Loader/Skid steer, Model FPT F5H FL463 A*GOOI, for use by the Wastewater Treatment Department, for the total acquisition cost of \$65,750.92, appears to be the best proposal for the purchase of this Compact Track Loader/Skid Steer, as determined by the Director of Public Safety and Service; now therefor

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Southeastern Equipment Co., Inc., 26580 State Route 7, Marietta, Ohio, 45750, for the purchase of one (1) Case TR270B, Diesel 4-stroke, Turbo, D.I., Compact Track Loader/Skid Steer, Model FPT F5H FL463 A*G001, for use by the Wastewater Treatment Department, at a cost not to exceed \$65,750.92, under the auspices of the Ohio Department of Transportation's Cooperative Purchasing Contract, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(B); according to the terms and conditions of the proposals attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which proposals are hereby adopted and approved.


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order to assist the Wastewater Treatment Plant in continuing its operations, thus ensuring the health and wellbeing of the general public, while protecting the streams and rivers surrounding Marietta, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, THIS Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
