

ORDINANCE NO. 210 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids (request for proposals) and enter into a multi-year contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, for the operation of the Marietta Family Aquatic Center, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids (request for proposals) and enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, for the operation of the Marietta Family Aquatic Center during the 2023-2024 pool seasons with the option of a two year extension for said contract for the operation of the Marietta Family Aquatic Center for 2025-2026 pool seasons, according to the specifications outlined in the Request For Proposals, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary to remain in compliance with the proposed timeline and for the Marietta Aquatic Center to open on schedule in 2023; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.




