

ORDINANCE NO. 221 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, or contracts, for the mowing, trimming, and policing of certain properties owned by, or under the control of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, or contracts, for the mowing, trimming, and policing of certain properties owned by or under the control of the City of Marietta, Ohio, according to the specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is required in order to allow for public advertisement for bids in a timely manner so the contract can be awarded prior to the mowing season; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
