


ORDINANCE NO. 223 (22-23)

An Ordinance to find and determine that a 2001 Case Skid Steer owned by the City of Marietta, Ohio, and used by the Waste Water Department, is personal property not needed for any municipal purpose and to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the sale thereof pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D), and declaring an EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

- Section 1: That pursuant to the estimate of value, recommendation, and approval of the Director of Public Safety and Service, it shall be and is hereby found and determined that a 2001 Case, Model 85 XT Skid Steer, owned by the City of Marietta, Ohio, and used by the Waste Water Department, as more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is personal property which is obsolete, unfit, or not needed for any municipal purpose.
- Section 2: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the sale of said skid steer, more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(D), the proceeds of the sale to be credited to the appropriate fund as required by law.
- Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary so the skid steer can be sold and credited to the proper accounts; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


