

ORDINANCE NO. 238 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with CT Consultants of Columbus, Ohio, to provide professional engineering services for the Colegate Drive Sewershed Study and Design Project, in an amount not to exceed \$260,000.00, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta has experienced several sanitary sewer overflows along Colegate Drive in the City of Marietta, which has impacted several residents and businesses along Colegate Drive; and

WHEREAS, before the problem of sanitary sewer overflows can be corrected in the Colegate Sewershed area, a comprehensive study needs to be conducted in order to ascertain where there are high areas of infiltration and inflow, taking into account wet weather volumes and wet weather peak flow ranges, and

WHEREAS, after the comprehensive study of the Colegate Sewershed is completed, a design plan for remedying the sewage overflow program will need to be developed, and

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from CT Consultants of 7965 N. High Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43235, of their scope of services for providing a comprehensive sewershed study and developing a detailed design plan to remedy the sanitary sewer overflow problems along Colegate Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta has determined that CT Consultants of Columbus, Ohio, is the firm most qualified to provide the professional engineering services needed for the sanitary sewer overflow problem along Colegate Drive, in the City of Marietta, Ohio; now therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract of behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio with CT Consultants of Columbus, Ohio, to provide professional engineering services for the Colegate Drive Sewershed Study and Design project, in an amount not to exceed \$260,000.00, per the specifications attached hereto, approved, marked as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary because we are entering the rainy season of the year (spring rains) and we need to be able to capture data of rain fall events so we can move forward in correcting the sanitary sewer overflow problems on Colegate Drive in the City of Marietta, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
