

ORDINANCE NO. 241 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to pay Ryan Boley, Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations Manager, an amount not to exceed \$9,929.63, for overtime hours worked by him, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in many positions of employment throughout the City of Marietta, employees are given "Comp Time" off from work to compensate the employee for hours worked beyond a forty-hour work week, in lieu of paying Overtime Pay to the employee. "Comp Time" is normally calculated at the rate of time-and-a-half, just as it would be calculated for Overtime Pay; and

WHEREAS, due to the Wastewater Superintendent being on extended temporary medical leave, Ryan Boley, Operations Manager at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, has had to perform the duties of the Wastewater Superintendent, as well as his own duties as the Wastewater Operations Manager. Consequently, as of February 22, 2023, Ryan Boley had accumulated 239.75 hours of "Comp Time"; and

WHEREAS, it would be detrimental to the operations of the Wastewater Treatment Plant if the Operations Manager, Ryan Boley, is away from his job for 239.75 hours; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Boley, has agreed to be compensated for the overtime hours worked by him through February 22, 2023, by accepting Overtime Pay, in lieu of taking "Comp Time" off work for the "Comp Time" hours earned by him through February 22, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta, Ohio has determined that it will be most feasible to pay Ryan Boley the sum of \$9,929.63, in lieu of extending him time off work for the "Comp Time" earned by him, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


- Section 1: That the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay Ryan Boley, Wastewater Plant Operations Manager, an amount not to exceed \$9,929.63, for overtime hours worked by him through February 22, 2023, in lieu of extending him "time off work" for the "Comp Time" earned by him.
- Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that Ryan Boley needs to be compensated for his exemplary work and conscientiousness in insuring and maintaining the operations of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, past his normal hours of work.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


