

ORDINANCE NO. 258 (22-23)

An Ordinance to amend the current Table of Organization for the City of Marietta, Ohio, for purposes of establishing a seasonal position of Harbor Master for the Marietta Harbor, and for establishing the salary, duties, responsibilities, qualifications and requirements of said seasonal Harbor Master, who shall serve under the direct supervision of the Director of the Public Safety and Service, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

- Section 1: That Exhibit "A" to Ordinance No. 186 (20-21) passed April 1, 2021, which established the City's current Table of Organization, shall be, and is hereby amended to reflect the creation of the seasonal position of Harbor Master for the Marietta Harbor.
- Section 2: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized to establish a seasonal position of Harbor Master for the Marietta Harbor, who shall serve under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service; and
- Section 3: That the Director of Public Safety and Service is hereby authorized to establish the salary, duties, responsibilities, qualifications and requirements of said seasonal Harbor Master position as outlined in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein; and
- Section 4: That the Director of Public Safety and Service has determined that the rate of pay for said seasonal position of Harbor Master shall be a Step-A-only rate of \$18.81 per hour. Furthermore, the Director of Public Safety and Service has determined that this recreational seasonal position of Harbor Master, shall NOT provide for any fringe benefits, other than Worker's Compensation, Medicare and Public Retirement System benefits. Additionally, the Director of Public Safety and Service has determined that the recreational seasonal position of Harbor Master, is ineligible for overtime or compensatory time, unless said position requires the Harbor Master to be employed more than seven (7) months per season, not counting the set-up and closure of building at Marietta Harbor.
- Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order to enable the Harbor Master to efficiently fulfill the duties of the recreational seasonal position, in order to serve


the public that utilizes the Marietta Harbor for recreational boat rental, overnight docking rental, fueling of boats with gasoline, refreshments and other various uses.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
