

ORDINANCE NO. 285 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Contractual Agreement with Hazen and Sawyer of Cincinnati, Ohio, based upon the quality based selection process, for Consulting Services in connection with the Duck Creek Interceptor Renewal Project at a cost not to exceed \$156,275.00 and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2022, the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio, passed Ordinance No. 58 (22-23), which authorized the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Contractual Agreement, based upon the quality based selection process, with Hazen and Sawyer of Cincinnati, Ohio for continued consulting services in connection with the Duck Creek Sewer Shed Evaluation and Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, based upon the quality based selection process, the City of Marietta, Ohio wishes to renew its Contractual Agreement with Hazen and Sawyer for their continued consulting and engineering services, including, but not limited to Hazen and Sawyer's detailed design, permitting assistance and bidding assistance needed for the Duck Creek Interceptor Renewal Project; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service, based upon the quality based selection process, shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contractual Agreement with Hazen and Sawyer, of 7870 East Kemper Road, Suite 100, Cincinnati, Ohio 45249, for continued Consulting Services, including, but not limited to, engineering services for detailed design, permitting assistance and bidding assistance for the Duck Creek Interceptor Project, at a cost not to exceed \$156,275.00, according to the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A, which Agreement is hereby adopted and approved.


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of




