

ORDINANCE NO. 288 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program Partner (CHIP) Agreement on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with the Washington County Commissioners; and the City of Belpre; and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta, desires to enter into a Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program Partner (CHIP) Agreement with the Washington County Commissioners and the City of Belpre, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this CHIP Agreement is to designate Washington County, Ohio as the lead project applicant for the 2023 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program, for the period of December 1, 2023 through April 30, 2026. The agreement will cover the CHIP program funds awarded from the State of Ohio's CDBG, HOME, and OHTF allocations. The agreement will remain in effect until the CHIP funds are expended and the funded activities are complete and closed out. None of the parties herein may terminate or withdraw from the partnership agreement while it remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, the Washington County Commissioners will be responsible for carrying out various activities, as the lead agency, and the City of Belpre, Ohio and the City of Marietta, Ohio will perform various services, as outlined in the Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program Partner Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; now therefore


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program Partner (CHIP) Agreement on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with the Washington County Commissioners; and the City of Belpre, Ohio, per the attached Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program Partner Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is hereby adopted and approved.


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that grant applications need to be timely submitted in order to obtain funding necessary to provide various needed services to the community, which services are provided through the Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
