

ORDINANCE NO. 303 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the disposal of sanitary sewage sludge from the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant into a sanitary landfill, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the disposal of sanitary sewage sludge from the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant into a sanitary landfill, according to the 2024 Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A, which proposal and specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order for the City to complete the bid process and award the contract to maintain continued service for the removal of sanitary sewer sludge at the best rate available to the City of Marietta, Ohio. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be and in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
