

ORDINANCE NO. 305 (22-23)

An Ordinance to amend Section 551.04 [Failure to Comply] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 551.04 of the Codified Ordinance of the City of Marietta, Ohio, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:


551.04 FAILURE TO COMPLY

(a) If the owner, lessee, agent or tenant having charge of or responsibility for maintenance of the lots or lands fails to comply with the notice, the Director of Public Safety and Service, or designated agent, shall thereupon cause the noxious weeds, grass or vegetation to be cut and destroyed or the litter to be collected and removed, and for such purpose he shall employ the necessary labor to carry out the provisions of this section. All expenses of labor and costs incurred shall be paid out of City funds not otherwise appropriated.


Section 2: That existing Section 551.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, shall be and is hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order for proper prosecution of violations. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be and in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


