

ORDINANCE NO. 356 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta Ohio, to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Ironton County Community Action, to apply for funding from the Appalachian Community Grant Program, to be used for the Levee Park Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service for the City of Marietta, Ohio shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Ironton County Community Action to apply for funding from the Appalachian Community Grant Program, with said funding to be used for the Levee Park Project.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that grant funding through the Appalachian Community Grant Program may be lost, if immediate action is not taken. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
