

ORDINANCE NO. 359 (22-23)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract with the Humane Society of the Ohio Valley Incorporated, for the impoundment, care and humane disposition of animals found running at large in violation of Chapter 505 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Humane Society of the Ohio Valley, Incorporated, for the period from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, for the impoundment, care, and humane disposition of animals found running at large in violation of Chapter 505 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, according to the terms and conditions of Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which terms and conditions shall be and are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that the present contract will expire on December 31, 2023; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor, but in no event prior to January 1, 2024.
