

ORDINANCE NO. 363 (22-23)

An Ordinance to amend Section 924.12(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, relating to charges for the discharge of wastewater to the wastewater treatment works of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That Section 924.12(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter, the following sanitary sewer rates shall be imposed and collected on and after January 1, 2024:

Inside and Outside City

(2) INDUSTRIAL USER CLASS ONLY

Industrial Monitoring Charges – See Section 924.11

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Section 2: That existing Section 924.12(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City shall be and is hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary to establish sanitary sewer charges in amounts projected to be necessary to provide funds to meet existing and anticipated costs for the operation, maintenance, renovation and improvement of the waste water treatment and collection system of the City of Marietta, Ohio; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor, but in no event prior to January 1, 2024.
