

ORDINANCE NO. 4 (24-25)


An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of up to 400 tons of rock salt for use by the Street Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of up to 400 tons of rock salt for use by the Street Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, according to the plans and specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary due to the competitive pricing of the rock salt and due to market availability; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
