

ORDINANCE NO. 43 (24-25)

An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project, (also known as the CDBG Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project), and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the sidewalks on Greene Street, between North Hart Street and Phillips Street, in the City of Marietta, Ohio are cracked, uneven, deteriorated, grown over and not ADA compliant, and therefore in need of reconstruction and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, this project consists of replacing up to 980 feet of existing concrete sidewalk, as money allows; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the existing six feet wide sidewalk will be replaced at the same width; and the portion of the existing ten feet sidewalk will be replaced at the same width; and

WHEREAS, curb cuts and simple ADA accessibility improvements may be made to meet ADA requirements; and

WHEREAS, there will be ground disturbance, but in areas that have previously been disturbed, due to having to remove the present concrete sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, there may be some work in the grass strip that would involve laying dirt, seed, and mulch; and

WHEREAS, activity delivery costs may be part of this project to cover engineering costs; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the total HUD Funded amount for this project will be \$105,000.00; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Director of Public Safety and Service shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project (also known as the CDBG Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project), according to the plans and specifications attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved, subject to any revisions by the Marietta City Engineering Department.


Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary to provide suitable pedestrian infrastructure on the affected areas of Greene Street, and to ensure that the sidewalks within the scope of this project are brought into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


