

ORDINANCE NO. 58 (24-25)

An Ordinance to create one (1) temporary seasonal laborer position in the Cemetery Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

- Section 1: That there shall be and is hereby created one (1) temporary seasonal laborer position in the Cemetery Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, to be filled by appointment, and to serve at no cost to the City. The temporary seasonal laborer in the Cemetery Department shall serve at the pleasure of the Director of Public Safety and Service pursuant to law. Said appointment is to be made no earlier than April 1, 2024, and said position shall terminate when funding is no longer available through the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, but in no event later than December 31, 2024.
- Section 2: That the duties of the temporary seasonal position of laborer in the Cemetery Department shall be those designated in the job description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and such other duties as the Director of Public Safety and Service may from time to time prescribe.
- Section 3: That the salary of the temporary seasonal position of laborer in the Cemetery Department shall be at no cost to the City, and is hereby established at the rate of \$12.00/hour, provided that the appointee to said position shall not receive fringe benefits from the City, other than Workers' Compensation, Medicare benefits, and premium pay at the rate of time and one-half per hour for each hour worked on a holiday.
- Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that immediate action is necessary in order to provide adequate manpower in the Cemetery Department;

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


