A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public, Safety and Service to install or place a six (6) foot Pullman Bench with back package plaque, on behalf of Marietta College's McDonough Center for Leadership and Business, in memory of Lucas Scott McVicar, on City property, in the park area near the intersection of Fourth and Ohio Streets, pursuant to the requirements of the Marietta Park Bench Donation Program Specification guideline, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


Section 1: That the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Public, Safety and Service to install or place a six (6) foot Pullman Bench with back package plaque, on behalf of Marietta College's McDonough Center for Leadership and Business, in memory of Lucas Scott McVicar, on City property, in the park area near the intersection of Fourth and Ohio Streets, pursuant to the requirements of the Marietta Park Bench Donation Program Specification guideline, and in accordance with the application attached hereto as Exhibit "A" which is hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that Marietta College's McDonough Center for Leadership and Business wants to present an opportunity for the public to pay tribute to Lucas Scott McVicar, a man who touched the lives of everyone he met.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
