

RESOLUTION NO. 11 (24-25)

A Resolution of the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to accept on behalf of the City, a donation of two vehicles from the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities, and Ewing School. Said vehicles, being a 2002 Chevrolet 9 seat passenger van with a rear handicap lift; and a 2005 Freightliner 14 seat passenger bus, will be used by the Marietta City Fire Department as a heating and cooling station to rehab Firefighters during prolonged incidents; and for transportation and training purposes. This Resolution shall be to accept this generous donation of vehicles with the sincere appreciation and thanks of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and the Marietta City Council to the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities and Ewing School, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities, and Ewing School have graciously offered to donate to the City of Marietta, Ohio, two vehicles to be used by the Marietta City Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the first vehicle is a 2002 Chevrolet 9 seat passenger van with a rear handicap lift. This vehicle is road worth and will be used by the Marietta City Fire Department at incidents that require transporting displaced individuals to designated locations. Furthermore, the van will also serve as a heating and cooling station to rehab Firefighters during prolonged incidents; and

WHEREAS, the second vehicle is a 2005 Freightliner 14 seat bus that is not road worthy. This bus will be used as a training prop at the new training site to be located at Jackson Park. Firefighters will be able to practice immobilization and removal of victims should such an event arise; now wherefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Marietta, Ohio, hereby accepts a donation of two vehicles from the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities and Ewing School. Said Vehicles, being a 2002 Chevrolet 9 seat passenger van with a rear handicap lift; and a 2005 Freightliner 14 seat passenger bus, will be used by the Marietta City Fire Department as a heating and cooling station to rehab Firefighters during prolonged incidents; and for



Section 2: That the Clerk of Council shall be and is hereby directed to spread a copy of this Resolution on the minutes of this body and to forward copies thereof to the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities and Ewing School, with an appropriate expression of this Council and the City of Marietta's sincere thanks.


