

RESOLUTION NO. 119 (22-23)

A Resolution to authorize and direct the Mayor to submit an application on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for total funding of \$721,000.00, for the 2024 Citywide Asphalt Resurfacing Project and the ADA Curb Ramp Project, and to obligate the necessary matching funds from the City if funding is approved; and declaring an EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Marietta, Ohio, is planning to make capital improvements to its streets and curb ramps in the form of repaving streets that are in need of paving and making curb ramps for handicap access as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement hereinabove described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, OHIO:


- Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Marietta, Ohio shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for funding of \$721,000.00, for the 2024 Citywide Asphalt Resurfacing Project and for the ADA Curb Ramp Project.
- Section 2: That the Mayor shall be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all additional documents and to enter into any agreements that may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance. Furthermore, the Mayor is authorized and directed to accept and administer the funds upon their award.
- Section 3: That this Council shall and does hereby further agree to obligate such additional sums necessary for this project, which shall be the City's share of matching funds, if the funding for this project shall be awarded.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be and is hereby declared to be an EMERGENCY measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and for the further reason that the funds in question are limited and may be lost if the City does not file its application by September 1, 2024; WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
