

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions Adopted by the Marietta City Council  
April 4, 2024

- **Ordinance No. 37 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to approve the Plat for the First Colony - Phase 2 Development Site and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 41 (24-25)** An Ordinance to amend Section 351.17 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio titled (Marietta City Parking Lots), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 42 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Harmar Concrete Sidewalks ADA Neighborhood Revitalization Project, (also known as the CDBG Harmar Concrete Sidewalks ADA Replacement Project), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 43 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project, (also known as the CDBG Greene Street Sidewalk Reconstruction & Rehabilitation Project), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 44 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Lower Norwood Loop Neighborhood Revitalization Project, (also known as the CDBG Lower Norwood Loop Neighborhood Revitalization Project), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 45 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of various chemicals for use by the Water Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 46 (24-25) AS AMENDED** An Ordinance to authorize Jonathan Brier to make certain improvements upon the street right-of-way in front of 622 North Seventh Street in the City of Marietta, Ohio, upon the express condition that Jonathan Briar indemnify and hold harmless the City of Marietta, Ohio, its officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns from any and all liability arising out of the construction or use of said street right of way, and to authorize the construction of the improvements called for herein, upon the issuance of proper permits therefor by the Director of Public Safety and Service, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 47 (24-25)** An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 269 (22-23), passed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2023, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 48 (24-25)** An Ordinance to declare the existence of a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Department of Public Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and its municipal utility, the Water Department, as a result of needed inventory of materials, and perhaps replacement of some of Marietta’s water lines, to ensure that any lead piping that may be located within said water mains can be replaced, so as to prevent an unhealthy condition that could detrimentally affect the citizens of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and therefore, to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract without formal bidding, advertising, and quality based selection, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 735.051 and 153.71(B), with Brown Equipment Company, of Evansville, Indiana, for the purchase of a 2024 Sewer-HX-9-TA Hydro-Vac truck at a cost not to exceed \$489,500.00 and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 49 (24-25)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 50 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply for, accept, and enter into a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account Agreement (**as a change of scope**), on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio for the purchase of a Hydro-Vac Truck to be used for potholing the water mains and lines in the City of Marietta, Ohio to locate any lines containing lead and for the further construction of safe drinking water facilities; **designating a dedicated replacement source** for the loan, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 12 (24-25)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio to place the One Hundred, Fifty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$150,000.00) of ARPA funds that was allocated and set aside as a contingency pledge, pursuant to Section 7 of Resolution No. 10 (22-23), that was passed on February 17, 2022, back into Marietta’s American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Fund; and to Repeal Resolution No. 10 (22-23), and declaring an EMERGENCY.

**April 18, 2024**

- **Ordinance No. 52 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize Lumos Networks of West Virginia, Inc., doing business as Segra of Charleston, West Virginia, as “Applicant”, to install a new aerial fiber optic cable, via underground (small hand dig trench) in the public right-of-way on Fourth Street with an aerial attachment along Marion Street to Muskingum Drive, out to Julian Avenue to the Wendy’s Restaurant, in the City of Marietta, Ohio, pursuant to an application filed with the Marietta City’s Engineer’s Office for work within the Public Right of Way, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 53 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the Water Treatment Plant Concentrate Sewer Construction Project in the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 54 (24-25)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Resolution No. 15 (24-25)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Veregy, of Columbus, Ohio, for a Preliminary Assessment of the City's buildings/facilities, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

**April 24, 2024**

- **Resolution No. 16 (24-25)** A Resolution by the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio, directing the Mayor of the City of Marietta, to provide a sustainable "Plan of Recovery" concerning the finances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to this Council on or before Monday, May 20, 2024, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
