

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions Adopted by the Marietta City Council  
March 21, 2024

- **Ordinance No. 11 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into and ratify a Cooperative Agreement for Sanitary Sewer Services on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with the Board of Commissioners of Washington County, Ohio, and to take such actions as are necessary therewith, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 14 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Mayor of the City of Marietta, Ohio to enter into an agreement on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with American Electric Power for the acquisition of a permanent easement in order to bring electrical service to the maintenance office located in the Oak Grove Cemetery (Parcel No 24-0096163.000), owned by the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 16 (24-25) AS AMENDED** An Ordinance to create two (2) seasonal laborer positions at the Marietta Harbor, in the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington County Job and Family Services Employment Programs, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 21 (24-25)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 22 (24-25)** An Ordinance to amend Section 121.01 [Time and Place of Regular Meeting] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 23 (24-25)** An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 (22-23), passed August 18, 2022, and to authorize and direct the Mayor; the Director of Public Safety and Service; and the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to enter into an Amended Master Equity Lease Agreement and an Amended Five (5) Year Capital Plan with Enterprise Fleet Management Trust, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 24 (24-25)** An Ordinance to establish a plan for the allocation of indirect costs incurred by the Water Revenue Fund; the Sanitary Sewer Fund; the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund; the Fire Department Levy Fund; and the Capital Improvement Fund, to the General Fund of the City of Marietta, Ohio; and to provide for the expiration of this Ordinance on December 31, 2024; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 25 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to transfer the sum of \$49,175.00 for the calendar year 2024, from the Capital Improvement Fund to the General Fund, for reimbursement for calendar year 2024, in respect to the indirect cost allocation provisions established by Ordinance No. 24 (24-25), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 26 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to transfer the sum of \$353,289.00 for the calendar year 2024, from the Streets Department Fund

to the General Fund, for reimbursement for calendar year 2024, in respect to the indirect cost allocation provisions established by Ordinance No. 24 (24-25), and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 27 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to transfer the sum of \$55,507.00 for the calendar year 2024, from the Fire Levy Fund to the General Fund, for reimbursement for calendar year 2024, in respect to the indirect cost allocation provisions established by Ordinance No. 24 (24-25), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 28 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to transfer the sum of \$450,821.00 for the calendar year 2024, from the Water Department Fund to the General Fund, for reimbursement for calendar year 2024, in respect to the indirect cost allocation provisions established by Ordinance No. 24 (24-25), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 29 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to transfer the sum of \$477,229.00 for the calendar year 2024, from the Sewer Department Fund to the General Fund, for reimbursement for calendar year 2024, in respect to the indirect cost allocation provisions established by Ordinance No. 24 (24-25), and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 30 (24-25)** An Ordinance to update the Salary Schedule and Job Description as it pertains to the position of the Wastewater Collections Foreman for the City of Marietta, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 31 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize Lumos Networks of West Virginia, Inc., doing business as Segra of Charleston, West Virginia, as an applicant to install a new aerial fiber optic cable, via underground (directional bore) in the public right-of-way from Greene Street to Putnam Street along Second Street, in the City of Marietta, Ohio, pursuant to an application filed with the Marietta City's Engineer's Office for work within the Public Right of Way, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 32 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize Beth Lepore to make certain improvements upon the street right-of-way in front of 516 Second Street in the City of Marietta, Ohio, upon the express condition that Beth Lepore indemnify and hold harmless the City of Marietta, Ohio, its officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns from any and all liability arising out of the construction or use of said street right-of-way, and to authorize the construction of the improvements pursuant to the application to work within the public right-of-way, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 33 (24-25)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 34 (24-25)** An Ordinance to create three (3) temporary seasonal laborer positions in the Public Works Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 35 (24-25)** An Ordinance to create one (1) temporary seasonal position in the Engineering Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, under the auspices of the various Washington

County Job and Family Services Employment Programs; to designate the duties therefor, and to establish the salary thereof, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 36 (24-25)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a Contract or Contracts for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Sludge Canopy Roof Replacement Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 38 (24-25)** An Ordinance to ratify the tentative Agreement entered into between the City of Marietta, Ohio, and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local No. 442, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 39 (24-25)** An Ordinance to repeal Chapter 163.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio titled Tuition Reimbursement and to grandfather in city employees who received approval by January 1, 2024, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 6 (24-25)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to permit the Civil War Round Table of the Mid-Ohio Valley to erect a historical marker, under the direct supervision of the Director of Public Safety and Service, upon the City's right-of-way, in the lawn strip in front of 508 Fourth Street, Marietta, Ohio, in order to honor the lifetime achievements of Brevet Brigadier General Rufus R. Dawes and his wife, Mary Gates Dawes, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 7 (24-25) AS AMENDED** A Resolution by the City of Marietta, Ohio, to accept and endorse the performance audit performed by the Auditor of the State of Ohio; and to agree to consider the recommendations contained in said performance audit; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 9 (24-25)** A Resolution by the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to formally adopt the Enrich Marietta Downtown Plan, as being a useful reference guide for future planning efforts for Marietta's Downtown, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 10 (24-25)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public, Safety and Service to install or place a six (6) foot Pullman Bench with back package plaque, on behalf of Marietta College's McDonough Center for Leadership and Business, in memory of Lucas Scott McVicar, on City property, in the park area near the intersection of Fourth and Ohio Streets, pursuant to the requirements of the Marietta Park Bench Donation Program Specification guideline, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 11 (24-25)** A Resolution of the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to accept on behalf of the City, a donation of two vehicles from the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities, and Ewing School. Said vehicles, being a 2002 Chevrolet 9 seat passenger van with a rear handicap lift; and a 2005 Freightliner 14 seat passenger bus, will be used by the Marietta City Fire Department as a heating and cooling station to rehab Firefighters during prolonged incidents; and for transportation and training purposes. This Resolution shall be to accept this generous donation of

vehicles with the sincere appreciation and thanks of the City of Marietta, Ohio, and the Marietta City Council to the Washington County Board of Developmental Disabilities and Ewing School, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Resolution No. 13 (24-25)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio to establish and designate the Urban Forestry Grant Fund, as a fund for the City of Marietta, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 14 (24-25)** A Resolution of support authorizing the Director of Public Safety and Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio to submit an application to participate in the 2024 Ohio Capital Bill budget appropriation in the maximum allowable amount for the Start Westward Monument Restoration Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
