

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions
August 3, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 294 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 333.11, (Electronic Wireless Communication Device Use Prohibited While Driving) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio.
- **Ordinance No. 302 (22-23)** An ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 303 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract or contracts for the disposal of sanitary sewage sludge from the City's wastewater treatment Plant into a sanitary landfill, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 304 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 551.03 [Written Notice to Destroy Weeds or Remove Litter] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 305 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 551.04 [Failure to Comply] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 306 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 551.05 [Fees] of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 307 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to allocate and/or set aside a portion of monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund (ARPA) to be used for the renovation of the Marietta Police Department Dispatch Center in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 308 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, for the Marietta Police Department Dispatch Center Renovation Project, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 102 (22-23)** A Resolution by the Council of the City of Marietta, Ohio granting a "reasonable accommodation" to Pathway Community Church, with regard to Marietta's zoning practices and enforcement, so as to permit Pathway Community Church to use the former North Hills Bowling Alley for religious Church services, although said building which is situated at 318 Colegate Drive, lies within a C-3 Zoning District, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 116 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to apply for, accept, and enter into a WPCLF Agreement on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, for a design loan for the Duck Creek Interceptor Renewal Project, (Infrastructure Improvements) and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 309 (22-23)** An ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Resolution No. 119 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Mayor to submit an application on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for total funding of \$721,000.00, for the 2024 Citywide Asphalt Resurfacing Project and the ADA Curb Ramp Project, and to obligate the necessary matching funds from the City if funding is approved; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 120 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Mayor to submit an application on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for total funding of \$530,000.00, for the Academy Drive Bridge Replacement Project, and to obligate the necessary matching funds from the City, if funding is approved; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
