

Summary of Ordinances and Resolutions  
July 6, 2023

- **Ordinance No. 291 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 292 (22-23)** An Ordinance to repeal Section 1037.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, in its entirety, in order to abolish the position of Water Director and the position of Wastewater Director that was created by Ordinance No. 140 (86-87); and furthermore, to amend the City of Marietta, Ohio's current Table of Organization to reflect the abolishment of said positions; and additionally, to repeal Ordinance No. 140 (86-87) in its entirety, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 293 (22-23)** An Ordinance to repeal Section 137.06(a)(b) & (c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, in its entirety, in order to abolish the position of Director as Community Development Administrator that was created by Ordinance No. 2 (80-81) passed on January 3, 1980 and then amended by the passage of Ordinance No. 139 (88-89), passed on December 1, 1988; and furthermore, to amend the City of Marietta, Ohio's current Table of Organization, in order to reflect the abolishment of said position; and additionally, to repeal Ordinance No. 2 (80-81) in its entirety, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 296 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a purchase contract on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Rush Truck Centers, of Cincinnati, Ohio for the purchase of a 2024 International HV607 4 x 2 dump truck for use by the Waste Water Department of the City of Marietta, Ohio, at a cost not to exceed \$117,016.39 and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 297 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 298 (22-23)** An Ordinance to declare the existence of a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation of the Department of Public Safety and Service of the City of Marietta, Ohio, wherein remediation work is needed immediately to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Marietta, Ohio, and, therefore, to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a contract or contracts without formal bidding, or advertising, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051, with GeoStabilization International (GSI) of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the Ohio River Wall Repair Project, at a total cost not to exceed \$120,000.00; and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 105 (22-23)** A Resolution to adopt the tax budget for the City of Marietta, Ohio, for the calendar year 2024, and to provide for submission of the same to the Auditor of Washington County, Ohio, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 108 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Law Director of the City of Marietta, Ohio, or his designee, pursuant to O.R.C. 733.53 to commence legal proceedings in the Common Pleas Court of Washington County, Ohio, against John H. Parsons, owner of property located within the city limits of Marietta, Ohio at 605 Pearl Street because said property is a nuisance property, a blighted property, and a dangerous property, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Resolution No. 109 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Law Director of the City of Marietta, Ohio, or his designee, pursuant to O.R.C. 733.53 to commence legal proceedings in the Common Pleas Court of Washington County, Ohio, against Deborah Streight (a.k.a. Deborah Littleton), and Brian Streight, owners of property located within the corporation limits of Marietta, Ohio on South Sixth Street, because said owners are unlawfully operating a junk yard upon said property, without a license to do so, which is in violation of Chapter 4737 of the Ohio Revised Code and Chapter 729 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 110 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize the Law Director of the City of Marietta, Ohio, or his designee, pursuant to O.R.C. 733.53 to commence legal proceedings in the Common Pleas Court of Washington County, Ohio, against Benjamin R. Brunton, doing business as B & B Development, LLC, owner of property located within the city limits of Marietta, Ohio at 1099 Colegate Drive, and against any other person or entity that may have a vested interest in said property, because said property is in violation of State and Federal regulations, Ohio EPA regulations and in violation of Chapters 1153 and 1156 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 111 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize Larry Strickland and Cindy Strickland to connect certain premises owned by them, located at 110 Browns Alley, Marietta, Ohio, which is outside the corporation limits of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to Marietta City sewer lines, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 112 (22-23)** A Resolution to authorize and direct the Mayor to enter into a Contract For Right Of Entry and a Permanent Utility Easement, on behalf of the City of Marietta, Ohio, with Mary L. Christy, as Sole-Trustee of the Mary Louise Christy Trust, Grantor herein, for the Ohio River Wall Repair Project, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Ordinance No. 295 (22-23)** An Ordinance to amend Section 154.02, (Composition, Term and Organization) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Marietta, Ohio, pertaining to the Board of Trustees of the Cemetery Endowment Fund.
- **Ordinance No. 299 (22-23)** An Ordinance to appropriate and/or transfer funds.
- **Ordinance No. 300 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Auditor of the City of Marietta, Ohio, to allocate funds in the amount of \$25,000.00, to be used by the Southeastern Ohio Port Authority (SeOPA) for purposes of assisting the City of Marietta, Ohio in the City's efforts to eradicate slum and blight, and for further assisting the City in the revitalization of said blighted properties, for the benefit of the City of Marietta, Ohio and the Community, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Ordinance No. 301 (22-23)** An Ordinance to authorize and direct the Director of Public Safety and Service to extend the present contract between the City of Marietta, Ohio, and 59 Green, Ltd., doing business as GreenCab of Athens, Ohio, for an On-Demand, After-Hours and Alternative-Hours,

Transportation Pilot Program, for approximately one (1) month, to-wit: until August 22, 2023, at a cost not to exceed \$15,155.00, and appropriating said monies from the American Rescue Plan Act Fund for the period of the contract extension, and declaring an EMERGENCY.

- **Resolution No. 113 (22-23)** A Resolution to accept the recommendation of the Tax Incentive Review Council, to approve the continuation of the Community Reinvestment Area Agreement entered into between the City of Marietta, Ohio and Historic Hippodrome/Colony Theater, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 114 (22-23)** A Resolution to accept the recommendation of the Tax Incentive Review Council to approve the continuation of the Community Reinvestment Area Agreement entered into between the City of Marietta, Ohio and Perry Associates Holdings, LLC, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
- **Resolution No. 115 (22-23)** A Resolution authorizing the Marietta City Community Development Director to apply for a \$2,500.00 Cemetery Grant, administered through the Ohio Department of Commerce, and declaring an EMERGENCY.
