



Marietta Tree Commission Procedure

The City of Marietta Tree Commission has updated their pruning / removal policy for City of Marietta trees. Homeowner may request a certified licensed contractor with the City of Marietta to prune their City tree at the homeowner's expense. This is an optional procedure, for City trees. The City will still be pruning and removing trees based on availability and City resources. This new option is offered to help the City defray the cost and manpower the City has experienced. The City has so many City trees to keep the maintenance in a timely manner. Please call City Hall to start the process or any other questions, 740-373-1387 . Please see the new policy below:

- Tree Commission Member visits tree site to approve or deny with work description.**
- Tree Commission will contact the resident once approved to contact a City registered Tree Contractor. Resident completes a permit.**
- No tree topping of any City tree.**
- Pruning trees between November and March unless an emergency to the health and safety of the public.**

- **All work ANSIA300 Standards for tree care maintenance.**
- **Tree Commission will monitor work from the Contractor.**
