

MT. MORRIS TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 368

AN ORDINANCE TO SECURE THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE AND GENERAL CONVENIENCE OF THE RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MT. MORRIS, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN BY THE REGULATION OF THE USE OF FIREARMS, PELLET-GUNS, BB-GUNS, OR BOWS AND ARROWS, WITHIN SPECIFIED AREAS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE TOWNSHIP OF MT. MORRIS, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

SECTION I. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to secure and maintain the public peace, health, safety, welfare and convenience of the residents and property owners of the Township of Mt. Morris, Genesee County, Michigan, by the regulation of the use of firearms, pelletguns, BB-guns or Bows and Arrows within said township and the approval of firearm ranges.

SECTION II. Title. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "HUNTING CLOSURE ORDINANCE."

SECTION III. Regulation of use of firearms. Hunting for any wild bird or wild animal with a firearm, pelletgun, BB-gun or bow and arrow or the discharge of a firearm, pelletgun or BB-gun except at shooting ranges approved by the township legislative body is prohibited in the following described area within Mt. Morris Township:

All of Sections 1, 12, 13, 14, 22, 23, 24, 27 and 34 except those areas in Sections 1 and 12 that are within the incorporated limits of the City of Mt. Morris, and those areas in Sections 23 and 34 that are within the incorporated limits of the City of Flint.

SECTION IV. Penalties. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than One hundred (\$100.00) dollars, or by imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION V. Validity. Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be valid.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall take effect on the 15 day of August, 1972. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

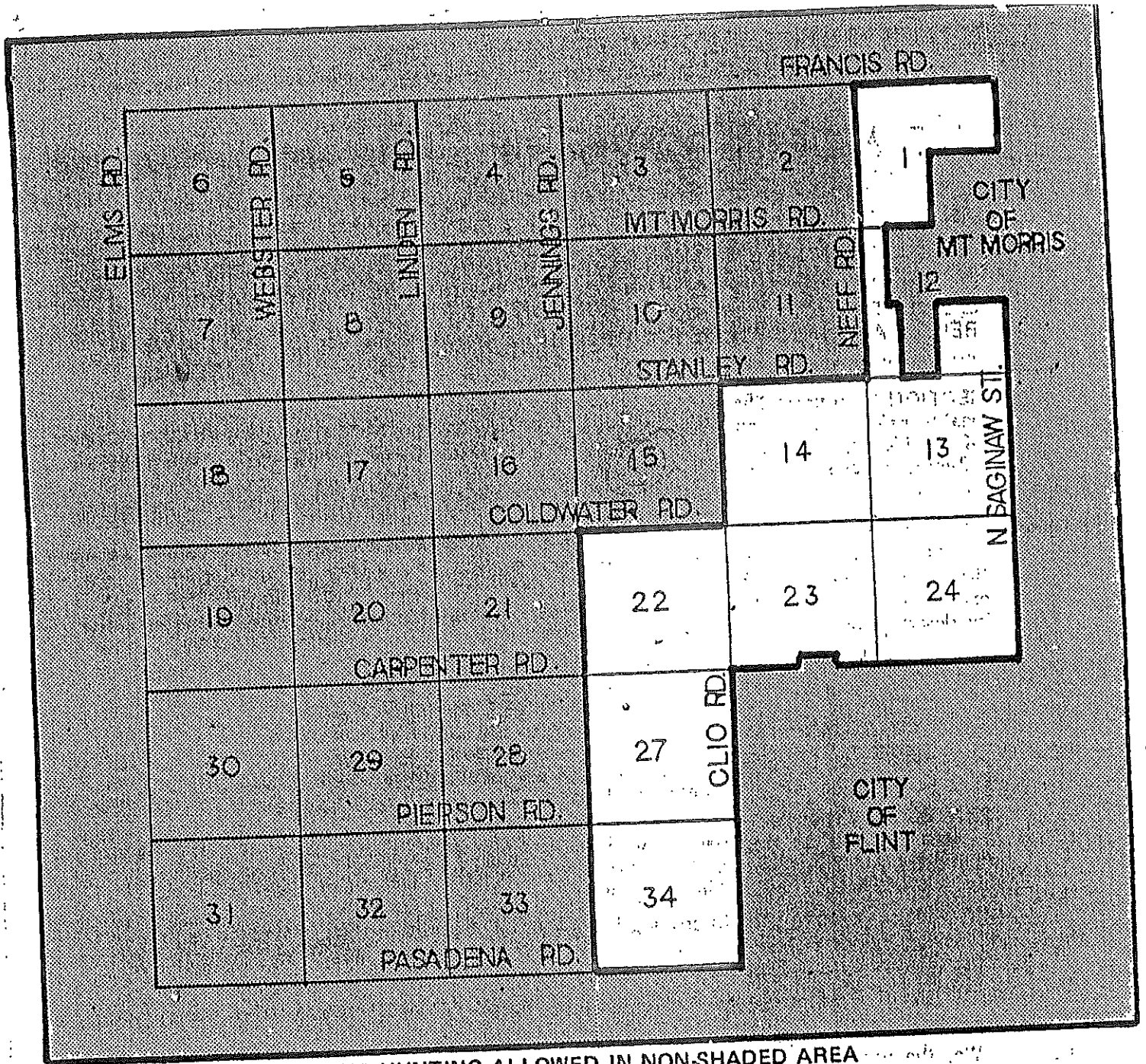
