#### 116.04 LICENSE FEES IMPOSED; RATE.

On and after July 1, 1999, there is hereby imposed an occupation tax upon all persons engaged in any any occupation, trade profession, or business, which occupational tax shall be measured and be equal to one percent (1%) of the gross annual salaries, wages, or compensation earned by any such person done for services performed or rendered within the city. (Ordinance passed 6/14/99)

### 1111.01 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this subchapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning: "<u>BUSINESS.</u>" The business carried on by any person who is an itinerant merchant, peddler, or solicitor as defined in this section. "<u>GOODS.</u>" Merchandise of any description whatsoever, and includes, but is not restricted to, wares and foodstuffs.

"<u>ITINERANT MERCHANT.</u>" Any person, whether as owner, agent, or consignee, who engages in a temporary business of selling goods within the city and who, in the furtherance of such business, uses any building, structure, vehicle, or any place within the city. "PEDDLER."

(1) Any person who travels from place to place by any means carrying goods for sale, or making sales, or making deliveries;

(2) Any person who, without traveling from place to place, sells or offers goods for sale from any public place within the city. A person who is a peddler is not an itinerant merchant.

### "PERSON." Any human being.

"<u>SOLICITOR.</u>" Any person who travels by any means from place to place, taking or attempting to take orders for sale of goods to be delivered in the future or for services to be performed in the future. A person who is a solicitor is not a peddler. (Ord. 04-40, passed 12-13-04)

I understand that failure to comply with chapter 111 of the Mt. Washington Code of Ordinance the penalty set forth in this ordinance may apply.

In order to obtain a TCU permit for each fireworks tent permit the following must be submitted. If one item is missing, all paperwork will be sent back.

- Application filled out for each location. \$60.00 made out to Bullitt Fiscal Court
- If company is an out of state vendor they need to get a transient merchant permit form the Bullitt County Clerk's office. 502-543-2513 / \$125.00
- Obtain fireworks tent permit from Code Enforcement for each location. 502-921-2970 / \$125.00
- Need aerial view with tent spotted.
- State permit for each location.
- Lease signed from both property owner and renter.
- If tent will be located in a city please contact the city for additional Permits.

□ At each entrance to the facility: "Fireworks—No Smoking" (2" minimum letters)

 $\Box$  At each exit and cash register: "No Fireworks Discharge within 300 Feet" (4 inch minimum letters)

### SAFETY CHECKLIST:

 $\Box$  A minimum of three clear exits are provided.

□ Only permitted consumer fireworks are available for sale.

 $\Box$  A facility evacuation plan exists.

□ There are NO dead end aisles.

□ No consumer fireworks are displayed or stored within 5 feet of a public entrance.

□ Aisles are clear and a minimum of 48" in width.

□ Fire extinguishers required:

Temporary stands less than 200 sq ft at least one.

Temporary facility/tent-travel distance to fire ext. no more than 35 ft.

Permanent locations-travel distance to fire ext. no more than 75 ft.

 $\square$  For temporary sites, storage container is at least 20 feet from retail sales. Fireworks

are secured when not open for business.

# NO Smoking Signs

1. NO Smoking in or within 50 feet of **Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales (CFRS)** NFPA 1 – 65.10.3.11.1

2. NO smoking signs posted at each entrance or within 10 feet of every NFPA 1 – 65.10.3.11.2 aisle. "FIREWORKS – NO SMOKING" signs posted in 2 inch lettering with Contrast background

\*\*NOTE: In accordance with NFPA 1 Section 65.10.4.8.3 and 65.10.4.8.4, exit signs and emergency lights

are not required for tents to be illuminated that are not open for business after dusk in accordance with

NFPA 1124 section 7.4.8.3 and 7.4.8.4.

• Temporary Stands (Not accessible to the public)

3. Fireworks shall be displayed in a manner that prevents handling by NFPA 1 - 65.10.6.4.6 persons other than staff

# • Temporary Stands (accessible to the public)

1. Stands less than 200 square feet only 1 fire extinguisher required NFPA 1 – 65.10.6.2.1

2. Approved safety and evacuation plan not required NFPA 1 – 65.10.6.2.2

**3.** Travel distance to exits shall not exceed 35 feet NFPA 1 - 65.10.6.2.3.2

• **Under The Influence** - NO sale of fireworks to anyone obviously NFPA 1 – 65.10.3.23 under the influence of alcohol or drugs

• **Training** - All personnel handling consumer fireworks shall receive training NFPA 1 – 65.10.3.22

• **Building Permit for Tent -** Building permit must be obtained to the 2013 KBC – 105.1 installation or erection of a tent over 399 square feet

• Fireworks registration displayed conspicuously for each location selling fireworks KRS 227.715(6)

• No person under 18 years old shall sell consumer fireworks at CFRS facility KRS 227.715(9)

without supervision of parent or guardian

• No person shall give, offer for sell any consumer fireworks to anyone under KRS 227.715(8)

18 years old



### **Fireworks Registration Types**

- 1. Limited Sales sale of fireworks as described in KRS 227.702(1).
- Seasonal Sales sale of fireworks described in KRS 227.702 (1) (2) and/or (3) during the following time frames: June 10<sup>th</sup> through July 7<sup>th</sup>, December 26<sup>th</sup> through January 4<sup>th</sup> or both seasons.
- 3. Primary Permanent year round sale of fireworks described in KRS 227.702 (1) (2) and/or (3) where fireworks are the primary source of business.

NOTE: In accordance with KRS 227.715(2), permanent business establishments open year-round and in which the sale of consumer fireworks is <u>ancillary</u> to the primary course of business shall only be permitted to sell fireworks described in KRS 227.702(1) or shall meet the criteria for "seasonal retailer" described in subsection (3) of this section. <u>All fireworks</u> registration fees are nonrefundable in accordance with 815 KAR 10:070.

### Fireworks Law & Regulation Requirements

- A COPY of a sales and use tax permit obtained from the Department of Revenue must be provided with the fireworks application to the State Fire Marshal as a condition of registration. To obtain your sales and use tax permit contact the Division of Sales and Use Tax at (502) 564-5170, or via e-mail at krc.webresponsesalestax@ky.gov.
- A fireworks registration form shall be submitted to the State Fire Marshal's Office at least 15 days prior to sell of fireworks or pay an additional fee of \$100.00 will be assessed for late submittals. You can check the status of your fireworks registration online at: <u>http://ky.joportal.com/License/Search</u>
- A transient merchants law (KRS 365.650 to 365.695) requires a merchant who spends less than 6 months in a locality in Kentucky each year, and not exempted, to obtain a permit from the county clerk of each county it conducts business 10 days in advance and post a cash or surety bond with the Office of the Kentucky Attorney General. You can contact the Office of the Kentucky Attorney General - Registration and Compliance Branch at 502-696-5534.
- A copy of the storage notification shall also be submitted to the local fire department having jurisdiction and the State Fire Marshal's Office at least 15 days prior to opening firework sales each year.

### Paperwork Required for Registration

- Completed fireworks registration application
- Storage notification
- · Copy of Kentucky sales and use tax permit
- Applicable registration fee (\$25.00 for Limited Sales; \$250.00 for Seasonal Sales; \$500.00 for Primary Permanent; and \$100.00 late fee if paperwork is submitted less than 15 days prior to the starting sale date)
- Tent site approval application if the location is under the jurisdiction of the Division of Fire Prevention with
  applicable tent site approval fee.

### **Fireworks Selling Requirements**

- No person or business shall give, offer for sale or sell any consumer fireworks listed in KRS 227.702 to any
  person under the age of 18.
- No person under the age of 18 shall sell consumer fireworks at consumer fireworks retail-sales facility unless the individual is supervised by a parent or guardian.



In accordance with KRS 227.715, each site at which fireworks are offered for sale shall have a firework . registration certificate displayed in a conspicuous location.

### Local Regulations

- Check with local government to ensure compliance with local laws and ordinances that may restrict the sale or . use of fireworks in their county or city.
- Check with city or county government to see if a local business license is required.

### **Building Code Regulations**

- Contact the Division of Building Code Enforcement at 502-573-0373 or local building code official to obtain site approval on fireworks retail locations prior to the sale of consumer fireworks.
- Each site shall comply with all provisions of the 2013 edition of Kentucky Building Code (KBC) and 2006 edition of 1124 National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). Permanent structures shall comply with section 429.3.1 of the 2013 KBC and temporary structures shall comply with Section 429.3.2 of the 2013 KBC.
- Existing businesses that sell the full line of consumer fireworks under KRS 227.702 must submit plans and details to illustrate compliance with NFPA 1124 and the Kentucky Building Code.
- For temporary structures submit the necessary plans and permits to the appropriate authorities.
- A certificate of occupancy for fireworks retail sales must be obtained prior to the sale of consumer fireworks in permanent facilities.

## Consumer Fireworks Retail Sales (CFRS) Permanent Structures Facilities

- For permanent structures submit the necessary plans and details along with registration to the appropriate authorities.
- In accordance with Section 429.3.1 of the 2013 Kentucky Building Code (KBC), any new CFRS structures shall be detached stand-alone buildings.
- Sale of consumer fireworks in a CFRS structure shall comply with provisions as set forth in section 429.3.1 of the 2013 Kentucky Building Code (KBC).
- In accordance with 2006 edition of NFPA 1124 Chapter 7.2.4 Retail sale of display fireworks (1.3g) shall be prohibited at any mercantile or consumer fireworks retail sale facility.

#### Mercantile Retail Sale

- Mercantile Stores shall comply with chapter 7.5 of NFPA and chapter 7.3.15 through 7.3.24.2 of NFPA 1124.
- Existing businesses that sell the full line of consumer fireworks under KRS 227.702 must submit plans and details to the appropriate authorities to illustrate compliance with 2006 edition of NFPA 1124.

### Stands / Temporary (Tent) Structures

- All facilities designated as stands or temporary stands shall comply with section 429.3.1 of the 2013 Kentucky . Building Code (KBC).
- In accordance with section 105.7.13 from the 2013 Kentucky Building Code (KBC), a construction permit is required to erect an air-supported temporary membrane structure or tent having an area in excess of 400 square feet.

# Information Bulletin – May 5, 2014

Effective January 1, 2014, there are changes to Section 429 and 430 of the 2013 Kentucky Building Code (KBC). For the purpose of selling fireworks tents larger than 399 square feet must comply with the below mentioned tent approval process.

For those selling fireworks in tents, a site approval may be required by the local building inspector. Where there is not a local building inspector, tent site approvals will be required by the Division of Fire Prevention. Locations with tent sites that are under the Division of Fire Prevention approval *will not* be issue a fireworks registration until a tent site location application is submitted and approved.

To avoid delays, I would encourage interested parties to begin the approval process as soon as possible. Detailed information regarding these changes can be found on the Department of Housing, Buildings, and Construction website under the link: <u>http://dhbc.ky.gov/sfm/Pages/Fireworks.aspx</u>
