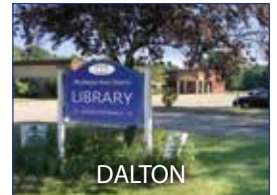


MISSION:

- Increased virtual usage by 41%



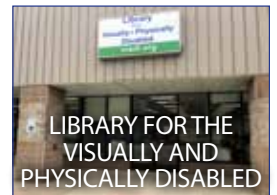

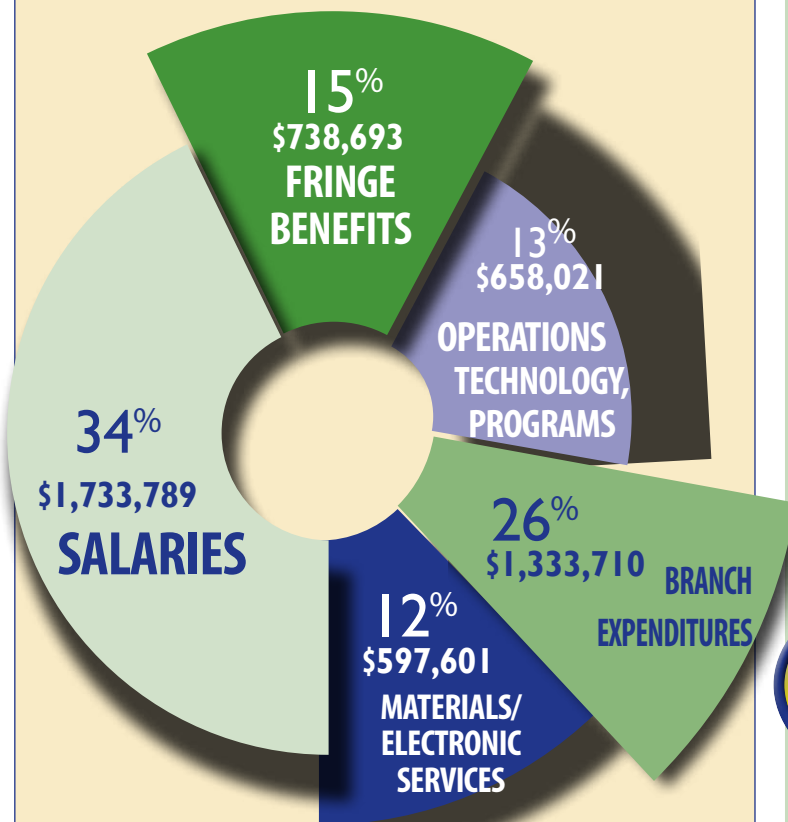
