


1. Updated Map





The Brosig Avenue project is designed to provide safer walking conditions to and from Brule Elementary into the surrounding neighborhoods and provide connection to future bike/ped projects. The projects would provide a 6' wide concrete sidewalk along the south-west side of Brosig Avenue. This sidewalks would be offset from the street's back of curb by 2' minimum in for safety and to accomodate existing mailboxes and trash cans.
