- C. Provide venues to receive feedback/input from the public.

Fiscal Policy

It is the desire of the Navasota City Council to operate efficiently and effectively under a balanced budget while investing for long-term planning to include the 2027 Strategic Plan.

Goals

- A. Ensure adequate revenues to support current and future infrastructure.
- B. Ensuring adequate revenues to support the Strategic Plan.
- C. Cost Benefit Analysis on all major expenditures while evaluating alignment with the Strategic Plan.
- D. Track and assess economic trends and their impact upon the Strategic Plan.
- E. Evaluate investment policy to maintain optimum growth.

Quality of Life / Parks / Recreation / Culture Policy

It is the desire of the Navasota City Council to support a Ten (10) Year Comprehensive Parks Plan and review it annually to ensure:

- E. We establish new facilities when demand exists.

Public Safety Policy

Goals

- A. Ensure adequate funding for staff and equipment.
- B. Continued development and enforcement of policies and procedures.
- C. Create community partnerships.

Community Development Policy

It is the desire of the Navasota City Council to achieve the desired objectives of the residents of Navasota to create a diversified community environment.

Goals

- A. *Residential Development*: to encourage quality, diverse housing including a variety of single and multi-family projects.
- B. *Downtown Revitalization*: to renovate the downtown environment and attract a diversity of professional and retail amenities.
- C. *Planning and Growth*: to establish criteria that retains continuity of the City's identity.
- D. *Historic Preservation*: to maintain the historic value of public and private properties in the city.
- E. *Green Initiatives*: to establish policies for commercial and residential properties.
