## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

### Collin County Outer Loop - Southeast

Collin County is conducting a study to finalize the alignment of the segment of the Collin County Outer Loop in the southeast part of the county from County Road 656 in Farmersville to the Rockwall County Line. The current study will refine the alignment and develop the schematic design and local environmental document.

Collin County is hosting an in-person and virtual public meeting to share information about the project and gather feedback from the public on the alignment variations under consideration. The in-person public meeting will follow an open-house format, where information will be on display and county representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. The virtual public meeting is not a live event. All public meeting materials will be posted to the project website at [www.CCOL-SE.com](http://www.CCOL-SE.com) and will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation, exhibit boards, and an interactive comment map.

#### **About the Study**

The Collin County Outer Loop is a 55-mile planned transportation facility that will ultimately span from the Denton/Collin County line, through cities including Celina, Weston, Anna, Melissa, Farmersville, Josephine and Royse City, to the Rockwall/Collin County line. This project consists of Segments 2 and 4, which extends approximately 14 miles, from County Road 656 in Farmersville to the Rockwall County line. A previous study evaluated the feasibility of multiple alignments and identified the previous Technically Preferred Alignment (PTPA) in 2009 and 2010. The Collin County Outer Loop – Southeast project will review the PTPA, identify needed adjustments to the alignment, and develop the Schematic Design and Local Environmental Document.

The project aims to address population growth in the southeastern portion of the county by enhancing north-south connectivity, managing congestion, and enhancing safety. Impacts to planned and future developments, existing floodplains, existing property lines, and other environmental factors will be minimized wherever possible.
