

ORDINANCE NO. 480

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 31.62 OF THE NORTH PLAINS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PARKS BOARD MEMBER TERMS OF OFFICE

WHEREAS, Chapter 31 of the North Plains Municipal Code (“NPMC”) addresses City committees, boards and commissions; and

WHEREAS, NPMC Section 31.62 specifically addresses Parks Board membership and terms; and

WHEREAS, NPMC Section 31.62(C) currently provides that the term of office of members of the Parks Board shall be for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend NPMC Section 31.62(C) to change the term of office from a period of two years to a period of four years.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NORTH PLAINS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 31.62(C) is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(C) Each succeeding term following the initial appointment shall be for a period of four years, and the Mayor shall, with the consent of the Council, appoint successors to such offices for each term of four years thereafter. Appointments shall be structured so as to ensure that terms overlap.

Section 2. The remaining sections of NPMC Section 31.62 remain unchanged.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after its adoption.
