DISCUSSION ITEM

- 2025 ROAD PROJECTS** The City Manager began discussion with potential road projects for 2025, incorporating the upcoming 2025/2026 fiscal year budget. Staff met with Coleman Engineering and reviewed 16 sections of roadway and grouped them together to develop a three-year path to completion. The City Manager provided recommendations for 2025, including the reconstruction (crush and shape) of five (5) roads totaling an estimated \$258,060.99. The council discussed recommended road segments, including cost estimates and other roads in need of improvements. It was agreed to bring back for further discussion and approval.
- BUDGET WORKSHOP SCHEDULE** The City Manager initiated conversation concerning the 25/26 budget preparation and desire to start scheduling workshops. The goal is to have one (1) workshop per week if possible, starting the first week in March to the last week in April. This will provide up to nine (9) workshops to get the budget ready for public hearing. The council discussed and agreed to bring back for continued discussion and approval.
- COUNCIL COMMENTS** Muraro – Thinking of those effected by the California fires.
Meneghini – Expressed awareness and gratification with the minor changes to the meeting agenda, aiding in streamlining actionable and discussion items.
