Seattle + Cedar Water Main Replacement & Complete Streets

SUBMITTAL OF SEALED BIDS: Notice is hereby given that the City of Pacific will receive only sealed bids through Friday, 6/21/2024, at 2:00 pm at the City Hall Clerks Department located at: 100 Third Avenue South East, Pacific, WA 98047. Proposals received after said date and time will not be considered. All timely bids will be opened and read publicly aloud in the City Hall Council Chambers, at 2:03 p.m. on Thursday, 6/21/2024.

This project consists of: Excavation & Site work, street improvements & HMA overlay, sidewalk & ramp improvements, storm water conveyance additions and/or replacements and water main replacements from AC to Ductile Iron, for the City of Pacific's "Seattle and Cedar" streets including limited work at the adjacent streets.

The City anticipates awarding this project to the successful lowest responsive bidder and intends to give Notice to Proceed as soon as the Contract and all required documents are executed in full. Assumed Schedule: 06-04-2024 = Bid Advertise Date, 06-07-2024 = Pre-Bid Conference, 06-21-2024 = Bid Opening Date, 06-25-2024 = NTP (Notice to Proceed), 06-28-2024 = Pre-Construction Meeting, 07-01-2024 = Contractor mobilization on/or before, 12-31-2024 = Substantial Completion. Regardless of the date of award or Notice to Proceed, the Contractor must complete all work by: December 31, 2024, 01-30-2025 = Final Completion. Time to complete the project is one-hundred ninety (190) calendar days from NTP. This project is subject to Liquidated Damages; per calendar day late beyond the substantial completion date.

PRE-BID MEETING: An informational meeting (non-mandatory pre-bid conference) will be held Friday, June 07, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. on ZOOM, to discuss the project. All prospective bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

OTHER PROVISIONS: All bids and this Project shall be governed by the Contract, as defined by the Washington State Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction 2024 (Standard Specifications), which is incorporated by this reference as though set forth in full.

All bid proposals shall be in accordance with the Contract and all bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid deposit or bond in the amount required in the Contract. Forfeiture of the proposal bond or deposit to the City shall be in accordance with the Contract. The recipient, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, (78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award. The City encourages minority and women-owned firms to submit bids consistent with the City's policy to ensure that such firms are afforded the maximum practicable opportunity to compete for and obtain public contracts. For bid proposals exceeding \$1M, each bidder shall submit: Form A (HVAC, Plumbing, and Electrical) with its bid proposal or within one hour after the bid submittal time/date. Form B (Structural Steel Install, Rebar Install) within 48 hours after the bid submittal time/date.
