This certification, along with a Citizen's Guide, a Performance Dashboard, a Debt Service Report, and a Projected Budget Report, must be received by December 1, 2022, (or the first day of a payment month) in order to qualify for that month's payment. 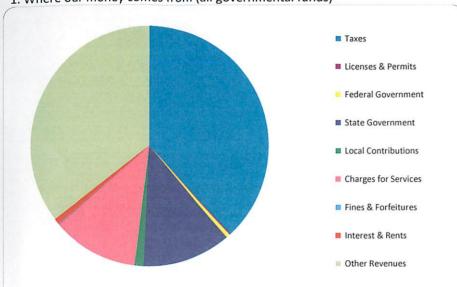

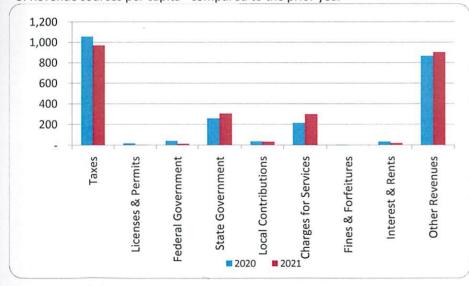

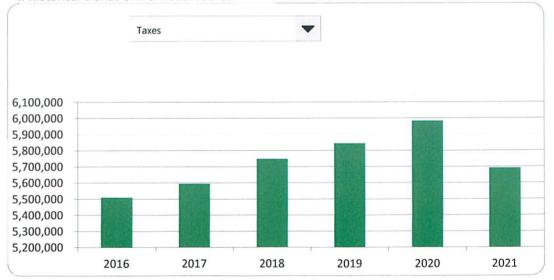

3. Revenue sources per capita - compared to the prior year

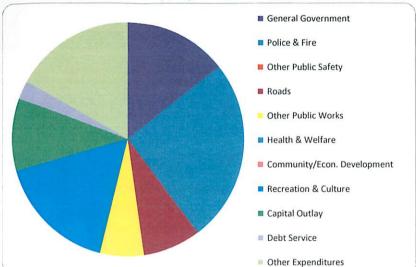


4. Historical trends of individual sources

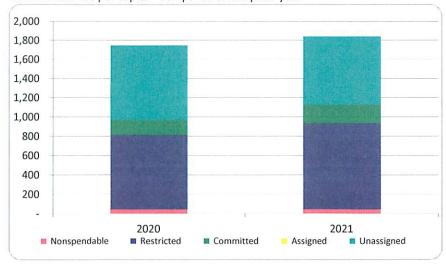
1. How have we managed our governmental fund resources (fund balance)?



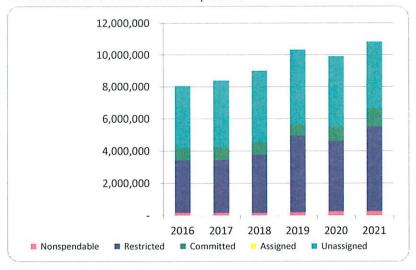

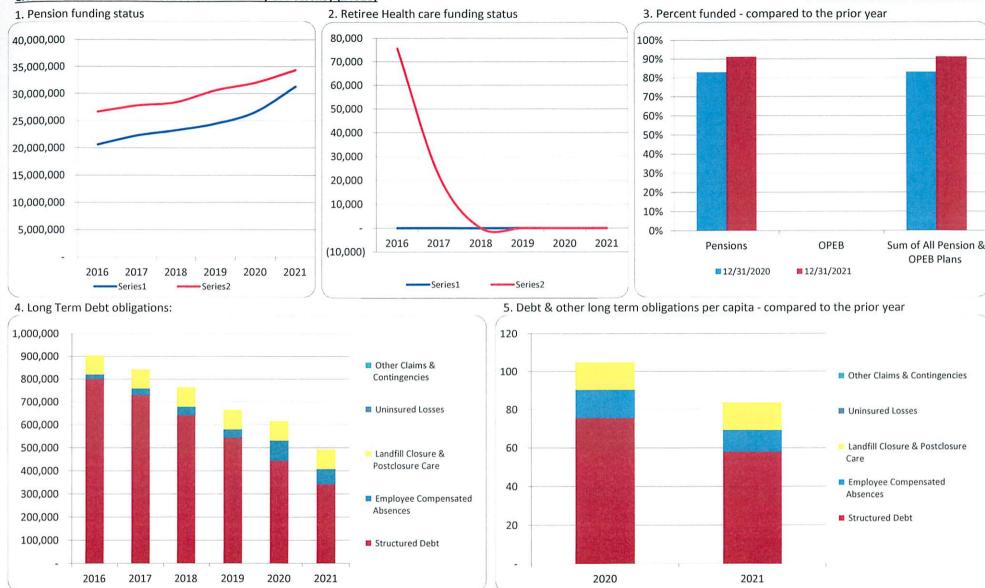


4. Historical trends of individual components
