Conduct Medical Marihuana Drawing for Provisioning Centers

The City Clerk performed drawing of applicant names for the three available medical marihuana provisioning center permits. All 16 applicant cards were folded in half, sealed and placed in a tumbler. The tumbler was spun and the 16 names drawn. Each card had the number printed on it in the order in which it was drawn. The names were also listed in order of how they were drawn on a note board. Each card was held up in front of the camera as it was drawn.

The drawing provided a list of applicants and City staff will review the names to determine the list of eligible applicants based on the 500 foot spacing requirement in the ordinance. A list is expected in one or two weeks.

Mayor Murphy asked for public comments and heard a comment to hold up the note board of the listing of applicants for further review.
