The Weekly Highlights

Public Works

Park Maintenance

A yard hydrant at the dump station was repaired. An electric pedestal at the campground was repaired. Pool cleanup is beginning. Crews are un-winterizing plumbing in the park bathrooms and offices. Easter eggs were delivered to the Presbyterian Church for cleaning.

Village Maintenance

Utility locates continue as needed. The Plain City banners were hung back uptown. Drywall and paint was repaired at the Administration building. Potholes were cold patched on St. Rt. 142 and Perry Pike. Crews attended the monthly Union County Safety Council meeting. Street sweeping took places on Coachman and Buckboard Lane. Snowplows were removed from daily driver trucks.

Sidewalk inspections

Crews have completed the village-wide sidewalk inspections. Next, we will be processing the data and making recommendations on how to move forward with repairs.
