Public Works

Park Maintenance

Breakers were replaced at the campground. Two story walk cases on the walking path were repaired. New gravel was installed on the walking path. The lights at the Aquatic Center have been reprogrammed. New chains were installed on the pool swings. Campsites were re-graveled where needed.

Village Maintenance

A first round of brush collection was completed. Trash was emptied throughout the Village. Street sweeping took place on Buggy Whip, Carriage and Lantern Lane. The crosswalk re-striping has been scheduled with the contractor for mid-May.

Storm Sewers

It was a busy week with the flooding around town. We received over 2 inches of rain in a 24 hour period. Several residents had issues that were inspected. McKittrick Park was closed most of the week due to flooding.
