NEW RESIDENT CHECKLIST

- Water and Sewer: Contact the Mid-Ohio Water & Sewer District to establish service.
- Trash & Recycling: Contact the Village to set up billing and collection.
- Electric and Natural Gas: Arrange for electricity and natural gas services from local providers.
- Income Tax: Contact the Village's Income Tax Department to make arrangements for tax filings.
- Change of Address Forms: Notify the post office and update your mailing address.
- Voter Registration: Register to vote by contacting the appropriate county Board of Elections.
- Vehicle Registration: Update your vehicle registration and driver's license with the Ohio BMV.
- Dog Registration: If you have a dog, register them with the appropriate county.
- File Permits: If you plan on building a deck, fence, or other structure, contact the Village for permits.
- Community Newsletter: Sign up for the Village newsletter to stay informed about local news, events, and activities.
- Emergency Notifications: Download the Plain City Mobile App to receive important alerts on your mobile device.
- Calendar of Events: Check the Village calendar of events to participate in community gatherings.
- Explore: Explore Plain City, including its parks, recreational facilities, restaurants, and local businesses.
- Volunteer: Consider joining various community organizations to network while making a positive impact on the community.
