

Ordinance No. 21-20

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COSTS FOR THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION FEE AND THE CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FEES FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has adopted an ordinance regulating the use of the Public Right-of-Ways, and,

WHEREAS, Sections 97.05 and 97.13(D) of the Village of Plain City Municipal Code require Council to set these fees annually; and,

WHEREAS, Now Council desires to set the rates and send invoices for 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLAIN CITY, MADISON COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

- Section 1.** Council hereby establishes and approves the following Right-of-way fee schedule for the Village of Plain City.
- Section 2.** The Registration fee for 2020 is calculated as \$259.35 per encumbered mile.
- Section 3.** The Permit fee for 2020 is calculated at \$72.25 per permit.
- Section 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of Plain City, Ohio, for the reason that the immediate imposition of annual right-of-way fees and registration requirements will allow the Village to continue to exercise all required and necessary controls over the use of the public right-of-way within the Village; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
