

CREATING A NEW FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING AND EXPENDING ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT DOLLARS

WHEREAS, the OneOhio Opioid Settlement of 2021 allowed local governments to settle with wholesale distributors of prescription drugs and receive funds from the settlement; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Governor and Attorney General has signed a settlement to help destroy the opioid crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Plain City has requested and received settlement dollars from the OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revision which is before Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village Council of Plain City, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Finance Director is authorized to establish a new fund for the OneOhio Opioid Settlement and any monies received through the settlement in subsequent years pursuant to all accounting and auditing principles.

SECTION 2: The Finance Director is authorized to receipt monies into this fund from the OneOhio Settlement Funds and to make appropriations as directed when such funds become available, and to make expenditures as permitted by law.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in effect and in full force at the earliest date allowed by law.
