

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE A WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT (208) PLAN WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Plain City is authorized, pursuant to R.C. 715.08, provide for the supply of water, by the construction of wells, pumps, cisterns, aqueducts, water pipes, reservoirs, and water works for the protection of such water supply, and, pursuant to R.C. 715.40, to open, construct, and keep in repair, sewage disposal works, treatment plants, and sewage pumping stations, together with facilities and appurtenances necessary and proper therefor; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Plain City operates a Village owned water and wastewater facilities to provide water and wastewater services to the residents of the Village of Plain City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Plain City, as well as its administrative staff, have devoted considerable time evaluating the existing Village water and wastewater treatment facilities to include repairs, improvements to same in order to determine the most appropriate course of action for the Village of Plain City in consideration of the public health, safety, welfare as well as considerations relating to the cost of such repairs and improvements in light of the future growth and development of the Village of Plain City; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Plain City engaged the services of a professional engineering firm to perform a feasibility study to evaluate the options available to the Village with respect to the provision of water and wastewater services; and

WHEREAS, upon careful consideration of Council's evaluation and the evaluation and recommendations of professional engineering services, the Council of the Village of Plain City determined that upgrades and expansion of its water and wastewater facilities is the most appropriate available option to serve the current and future growth of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Village's desire to upgrade and expand its water and wastewater facilities it is necessary and appropriate to expand its current service area and to amend the Village's existing Water Quality Management Plan (208 Plan) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Plain City authorizes the Village Administrator to prepare, in conjunction with the Village's Engineer, and file a petition with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to amend the Village's existing Water Quality Management (208) Plan and service area.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Plain City, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. Council hereby approves the amendment of the Village's Water Quality Management (208) Plan and service area for filing with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

Section 2. Council hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to endorse, on behalf of the Village of Plain City, the Petition for amendment of the Village's Water Quality Management (208) Plan and service area and to take all necessary steps to file the same with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective from and after the earliest period provided by law.
