Proposal for Pontiac Police Service Millage

Based on 2018 taxable value of 700,000,000 for the City of Pontiac, the below millage rates would generate this revenue for additional police services:

- 1 mill = approx. \$616,000
- 1.25 mill = approx. \$770,000
- 1.5 mill = approx. \$924,000

For a resident this would be the approximate tax burden based on home with the taxable value of \$30,000 (City of Pontiac average):

- 1 mill = \$30 increase
- 1.25 mill = \$37.50 increase
- 1.5 mill = \$45 increase

Using the above approximate estimates the Sheriff's Office would be able to provide the following:

1 mill

- 3 additional Deputies assigned to the Directed Patrol Unit (DPU)
- 1 additional Deputy assigned to Youth Recreation/Community Policing

1.25 mill

- 3 additional Deputies assigned to the Directed Patrol Unit (DPU)
- 1 additional Sergeant assigned to DPU as the Unit Leader
- 1 additional Deputy assigned to Youth Recreation/Community Policing

1.5 mill

- 4 additional Deputies assigned to the Directed Patrol Unit (DPU)
- 1 additional Sergeant assigned to DPU as the Unit Leader
- 1 additional Deputy assigned to Youth Recreation/Community Policing
