AGENDA

1. Financial Report

- The total investments in all funds for the City as of 12-31-2017 was \$54,065,574. The general fund portion is \$21,808,290. A switch in the payment to Oakland County for the Sheriff's services contributes to the increase in the fund as the new contract requires that payments are made after the services are provided vs prepayments under the old contract. As a consequence, there is a 1 month lag schedule on the prepayments resulting in approximately \$1,000,00 dollars in cash flow accumulation.
- Income tax reports show that from July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017, \$6,426,764 was collected in 2016-2017 fiscal year or \$342,532 less than the previous fiscal year. The income tax revenue that was provided from HP is no longer as HP is moving out of the City.
- Property tax collections for the first 2 quarters of the fiscal year ending December 31, 2017 were 86.2 percent of total amount to be collected for the year, 1.8% more was collected this year as compared to the same period last year.
- The annual audit of the financial statements was conducted by the accounting firm Rehmann and a "clean" opinion was issued for financial statements ending June 30, 2017.

2. Medical Dispatch Contract

- The contract has been in place since 2011 and terminates the end of March.
- The current contract amount is \$14,000.
- The 911 call goes to the County first and then to STAR EMS
- It was suggested that Commissioner Bowman should be invited to speak on the new, proposed contract.
- A question was asked, how many professional services contracts are in the budget? Documents to be provided at the next meeting along with monthly check registers.

3. Property Tax Collection

- The charter was amended to extend the time to allow people to pay taxes until the end of August.

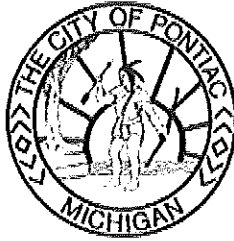

SUBJECT: Budget amendment FY 2017-2018

Mayor Waterman,

After reviewing our budgeted appropriations for the FY 2017-2018 (current year) we have determined that the appropriations in the General Fund and Cemetery Fund need to be increased in the current year as follows:

General Fund: I am proposing to increase the revenues by \$45,000 and the appropriations for the function of Other Services and Charges by \$45,000.

This appropriation corresponds with the increased fees for Planning Services which will be covered by the subsequent billing to recover these fees, so the net effect on the General Fund for this item will be "0"

Also, we need to re-allocate appropriations in the amount of \$1,250,000 from Personnel Services function (Retiree Fringes) to Transfer's out to Insurance Fund, in order to prepare for the upcoming settlement with CPREA and it's required contribution.

Cemetery Fund: I am proposing to increase the Revenues by \$10,000 and the total appropriations by \$130,471. The need to increase appropriations is necessitated by the increase in costs to maintain the two cemeteries, Oak Hill and Ottawa Park as well as costs of burials and other services. Detailed increases in these functions are being presented in the attached document.

The increased appropriations will be funded by use of the accumulated fund balance in the Cemetery Fund without the need to transfer any additional amount from General Fund in the current fiscal year.

If the council agrees with the budget amendments here is the resolution needed to pass:

Whereas, the City of Pontiac timely approved the 2017-2018 budget on June 8, 2017, and;

Whereas, the Mayor and Finance Director after reviewing the current level of expenditures for the General Fund and Cemetery Fund have concluded that the appropriations in the General Fund and Cemetery Fund require an increase of \$45,000 and 130,471 respectively, and;

Whereas, there is a need to reallocate the current amount of \$1,250,000 scheduled as Retiree Fringe benefit to be paid out to VEBA, to a Transfer Out to Insurance Fund, therefore increasing the appropriations in Transfer's out by \$1,250,000 and decreasing the appropriations in Personnel Services by \$1,250,000. Therefore this reallocation does not increase overall appropriations in the General Fund,

Whereas, Mayor is proposing to the City Council to increase the appropriations for the current fiscal year 2017-2018 for the General Fund and Cemetery Fund in amounts described above as necessary to fully account for this fiscal year expenditures in these funds ; and,

Whereas, the increased appropriations will not cause the fund balance in the General Fund to go below the policy mandated thresholds; and,

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the City Council of the City of Pontiac approves the budget amendments for the fiscal year 2017-2018 as requested by the Mayor and detailed in the attachment labeled exhibit A.

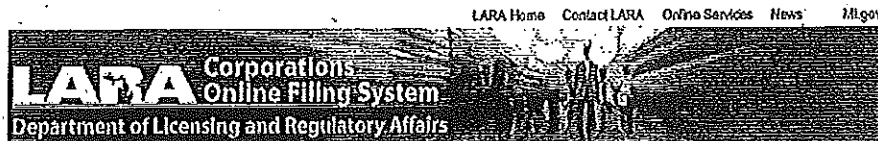

I. PURPOSE

To solicit bids from qualified individuals or firms to perform concrete patching work for the **ORCHARD LAKE ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT** consisting of Orchard Lake Road from Voorheis Street to Woodward Avenue for the City of Pontiac.

II. BACKGROUND

The City of Pontiac has allocated funds for the rehabilitation of Orchard Lake Road from Voorheis Street to Woodward Avenue, the total length of improved roadway will be 1.2 miles. Commercial General Liability Insurance The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Commercial General Liability Insurance on an "Occurrence Basis" with limits of liability not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence and aggregate for Personal Injury, Bodily Injury and Property Damage, coverage shall include the following extensions: (A) Contractual Liability; (B) Products and Completed Operations; (C) Independent Contractors Coverage; (D) Broad Form General Liability Extensions or equivalent, if not already included;

3. Motor Vehicle Liability The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract Michigan No-Fault Coverages, with limits of liability not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence, combined single limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage. Coverage shall include all owned vehicles, all non-owned vehicles, and all hired vehicles.

4. Professional Liability Insurance The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Professional Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and aggregate. If this policy is claims made form, then the Contractor shall be required to keep the policy in force, or purchase "tail" coverage, for a minimum of 3 years after the termination of this contract.

5. Additional Insured: Commercial General Liability and Motor Vehicle Liability, as described above, shall include an endorsement stating that the following shall be Additional Insureds: The City of Pontiac, Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner and Nowak and Fraus Engineers, all elected and appointed officials, all employees and volunteers, all boards, commissions, and/or authorities and board members, including employees and volunteers. 6. Cancellation Notice: All policies, as described above, shall include an endorsement stating that it is understood and agreed Thirty (30) days, Ten (10) days for non-payment of premium, Advance Written Notice of Cancellation, Non-Renewal, Reduction, and/or Material Change shall be sent to: City Administrator for the City of Pontiac.

7. Proof of Insurance Coverage: The Contractor shall provide the City of Pontiac at the time that the contracts are returned by him/her for execution, a Certificate of Insurance as well as the required endorsements. In lieu of required endorsements, if applicable, a copy of the policy sections where coverage is provided for additional insured and cancellation notice would be acceptable. Copies or certified copies of all policies mentioned above shall be furnished, if so requested.

3. INDEMNIFICATION CLAUSE

To the extent permitted by law, the Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Pontiac for and from all claims, demands, payments, suits, actions, recoveries, and judgments; of every name and description, brought or recovered against them or to property received or sustained by any person or persons whomsoever by reason of any action or omission of the said Contractor, his agents, servants, or his Contractors in the performance of said Work, or by or in consequence of any negligence or carelessness in connection with the same or on account of the death of or injuries to persons who shall be engaged in or about the work to be performed under this Contract; and on account of liability or obligation imposed directly or indirectly upon the City of Pontiac by reasons of any law of the State or the United States, now existing or which shall hereafter be enacted, imposing any liability or obligation, or providing for compensation to any person or persons on account of or arising from the death of, or injuries to employees. Said Contractor shall pay, settle, compromise and procure the discharge of any and all such claims and all such losses, damages, expenses, liabilities, and obligations, and shall defend at his own cost and expense any and all claims, demands, suits and actions made or brought against the City of Pontiac, and all Additional Named Assured, for or upon any such claim. In case the said Contractor shall fail, neglect, or refuse to comply with any of the provisions of this paragraph, the City of Pontiac may, in order to protect itself, and all Additional Named Assured, from liability, defend any such claim, demand, suits or action and pay, settle, compromise, and procure the discharge thereof, in which case the said Contractor shall repay the City of Pontiac any and all such loss, damage and expense, including attorney's fees paid, suffered or incurred by the City of Pontiac, and all Additional Named Assured, in so doing. So much of the monies due, or to become due, to said Contractor under this agreement as shall be deemed necessary by the City of Pontiac, shall or may be retained by the City of Pontiac until every and all such claims, demands, suits, actions, recoveries, judgments, liabilities and obligations have been settled and discharged and evidence to that effect furnished the City of Pontiac, or the City of Pontiac may collect the same in whole or in part in any lawful manner from said Contractor. The Contractor shall provide adequate insurance until his work is completed, with a reasonable insurance company which meets with the approval of the City of Pontiac, covering liability to the public for loss resulting from injury to persons or damage to property arising out of or caused by his operations, acts, or omissions, or those of his subcontractors, agents, or employees in procuring work for the City of Pontiac. Such insurance coverage shall be in such amounts as are provided in public liability and property damage section herein, provided, however, that such insurance coverage shall include an endorsement providing that the contractual exclusion shall be removed or in the alternative, contractual insurance shall be afforded. If the former, such endorsement shall contain specific language as follows:

"It is hereby agreed that the contractual exclusion does not apply to the contract entered into between the insured and the City of Pontiac, and each Additional Named Assured as their interest may appear for the project work. Such insurance coverage shall also contain an endorsement guaranteeing that thirty (30) days' notice to the City of Pontiac and each Additional Named Assured, shall be given in writing prior to the cancellation of, or change in any such insurance."

4. EXTRAS

No claim for extra compensation because of either decrease or increase in quantities will be allowed. Contractor and Owner mutually agree that in the event the Contractor is to perform services beyond, or at variance with the Scope and total price of this Contract, such services must be mutually agreed to, in advance, in writing, with agreed upon price included. Accordingly, claims for the payment of Extra Services must be substantiated by the Contractor with a written order signed by Owner or his authorized agent.

5. EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS

The Contractor must submit Emergency (24 Hours) phone numbers on the company letterhead when submitting contracts.

6. INCLUDED WORK

All items of work noted on the Plans or in the Specifications that are not specifically noted in the bid, shall be considered as included with the contract and shall be completed at no extra cost to the Owner.

7. SUB-CONTRACTS

The Contractor shall not execute an Agreement with any Sub-Contractor or sub-subcontractor or permit any sub-subcontractor to perform any work included in this Contract without the prior written consent of Owner.

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS (EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246)

- a) The equal opportunity clause published at 41 CFR 60-1.4(a) of this chapter is required to be included in, and is part of, all nonexempt Federal contracts and subcontracts, including construction contracts and subcontracts. The equal opportunity clause published at 41 CFR 60-1.4(b) is required to be included in, and is a part of, all nonexempt federally assisted construction contracts and subcontracts. In addition to the clauses described above, all Federal contracting officers, all applicants and all non-construction contractors, as applicable, shall include the specifications set forth in this section in all Federal and federally assisted construction contracts in excess of \$10,000 to be performed in geographical areas designated by the Director pursuant to Sec. 60-4.6 of this part and in construction subcontracts in excess of \$10,000 necessary in whole or in part to the performance of non-construction Federal contracts and subcontracts covered under the Executive order.

Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications (Executive Order 11246)

1. As used in these specifications:
 - a. "Covered area" means the geographical area described in the solicitation from which this contract resulted;
 - b. "Director" means Director, Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs, United States Department of Labor, or any person to whom the Director delegates authority;
 - c. "Employer identification number" means the Federal Social Security number used on the Employer's Quarterly Federal Tax Return, U.S. Treasury Department Form 941.
 - d. "Minority" includes:
 - (i) Black (all persons having origins in any of the Black African racial groups not of Hispanic origin);
 - (ii) Hispanic (all persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American or other Spanish Culture or origin, regardless of race);
 - (iii) Asian and Pacific Islander (all persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian Subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands); and
 - (iv) American Indian or Alaskan Native (all persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and maintaining identifiable tribal affiliations through membership and participation or community identification).
2. Whenever the Contractor, or any Subcontractor at any tier, subcontracts a portion of the work involving any construction trade, it shall physically include in each subcontract in excess of \$10,000 the provisions of these specifications and the Notice which contains the applicable goals for minority and female participation and which is set forth in the solicitations from which this contract resulted.
3. If the Contractor is participating (pursuant to 41 CFR 60-4.5) in a Hometown Plan approved by the U.S. Department of Labor in the covered area either individually or through an association, its affirmative

action obligations on all work in the Plan area (including goals and timetables) shall be in accordance with that Plan for those trades which have unions participating in the Plan. Contractors must be able to demonstrate their participation in and compliance with the provisions of any such Hometown Plan. Each Contractor or Subcontractor participating in an approved Plan is individually required to comply with its obligations under the EEO clause, and to make a good faith effort to achieve each goal under the Plan in each trade in which it has employees. The overall good faith performance by other Contractors or Subcontractors toward a goal in an approved Plan does not excuse any covered Contractor's or Subcontractor's failure to take good faith efforts to achieve the Plan goals and timetables.

4. The Contractor shall implement the specific affirmative action standards provided in paragraphs 7 a through p of these specifications. The goals set forth in the solicitation from which this contract resulted are expressed as percentages of the total hours of employment and training of minority and female utilization the Contractor should reasonably be able to achieve in each construction trade in which it has employees in the covered area. Covered Construction contractors performing construction work in geographical areas where they do not have a Federal or federally assisted construction contract shall apply the minority and female goals established for the geographical area where the work is being performed. Goals are published periodically in the Federal Register in notice form, and such notices may be obtained from any Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs office or from Federal procurement contracting officers. The Contractor is expected to make substantially uniform progress in meeting its goals in each craft during the period specified.
5. Neither the provisions of any collective bargaining agreement, nor the failure by a union with whom the Contractor has a collective bargaining agreement, to refer either minorities or women shall excuse the Contractor's obligations under these specifications, Executive Order 11246, nor the regulations promulgated pursuant thereto.
6. In order for the nonworking training hours of apprentices and trainees to be counted in meeting the goals, such apprentices and trainees must be employed by the Contractor during the training period, and the Contractor must have made a commitment to employ the apprentices and trainees at the completion of their training, subject to the availability of employment opportunities. Trainees must be trained pursuant to training programs approved by the U.S. Department of Labor.
7. The Contractor shall take specific affirmative actions to ensure equal employment opportunity. The evaluation of the Contractor's compliance with these specifications shall be based upon its effort to achieve maximum results from its actions. The Contractor shall document these efforts fully, and shall implement affirmative action steps at least as extensive as the following:
 - a. Ensure and maintain a working environment free of harassment, intimidation, and coercion at all sites, and in all facilities at which the Contractor's employees are assigned to work. The Contractor, where possible, will assign two or more women to each construction project. The Contractor shall specifically ensure that all foremen, superintendents, and other on-site supervisory personnel are aware of and carry out the Contractor's obligation to maintain such a working environment, with specific attention to minority or female individuals working at such sites or in such facilities.
 - b. Establish and maintain a current list of minority and female recruitment sources, provide written notification to minority and female recruitment sources and to community organizations when the Contractor or its unions have employment opportunities available, and maintain a record of the organizations' responses.

- c. Maintain a current file of the names, addresses and telephone numbers of each minority and female off-the-street applicant and minority or female referral from a union, a recruitment source or community organization and of what action was taken with respect to each such individual. If such individual was sent to the union hiring hall for referral and was not referred back to the Contractor by the union or, if referred, not employed by the Contractor, this shall be documented in the file with the reason therefor, along with whatever additional actions the Contractor may have taken.
- d. Provide immediate written notification to the Director when the union or unions with which the Contractor has a collective bargaining agreement has not referred to the Contractor a minority person or woman sent by the Contractor, or when the Contractor has other information that the union referral process has impeded the Contractor's efforts to meet its obligations.
- e. Develop on-the-job training opportunities and/or participate in training programs for the area which expressly include minorities and women, including upgrading programs and apprenticeship and trainee programs relevant to the Contractor's employment needs, especially those programs funded or approved by the Department of Labor. The Contractor shall provide notice of these programs to the sources compiled under 7b above.
- f. - g. Review, at least annually, the company's EEO policy and affirmative action obligations under these specifications with all employees having any responsibility for hiring, assignment, layoff, termination or other employment decisions including specific review of these items with onsite supervisory personnel such as Superintendents, General Foremen, etc., prior to the initiation of construction work at any job site. A written record shall be made and maintained identifying the time and place of these meetings, persons attending, subject matter discussed, and disposition of the subject matter.
- h. Disseminate the Contractor's EEO policy externally by including it in any advertising in the news media, specifically including minority and female news media, and providing written notification to and discussing the Contractor's EEO policy with other Contractors and Subcontractors with whom the Contractor does or anticipates doing business.
- i. Direct its recruitment efforts, both oral and written, to minority, female and community organizations, to schools with minority and female students and to minority and female recruitment and training organizations serving the Contractor's recruitment area and employment needs. Not later than one month prior to the date for the acceptance of applications for apprenticeship or other training by any recruitment source, the Contractor shall send written notification to organizations such as the above, describing the openings, screening procedures, and tests to be used in the selection process.
- j. Encourage present minority and female employees to recruit other minority persons and women and, where reasonable, provide after school, summer and vacation employment to minority and female youth both on the site and in other areas of a Contractor's work force.

- k. Validate all tests and other selection requirements where there is an obligation to do so under 41 CFR Part 60-3.
 - l. Conduct, at least annually, an inventory and evaluation at least of all minority and female personnel for promotional opportunities and encourage these employees to seek or to prepare for, through appropriate training, etc., such opportunities.
 - m. Ensure that seniority practices, job classifications, work assignments and other personnel practices, do not have a discriminatory effect by continually monitoring all personnel and employment related activities to ensure that the EEO policy and the Contractor's obligations under these specifications are being carried out.
 - n. Ensure that all facilities and company activities are nonsegregated except that separate or single-user toilet and necessary changing facilities shall be provided to assure privacy between the sexes.
 - o. Document and maintain a record of all solicitations of offers for subcontracts from minority and female construction contractors and suppliers, including circulation of solicitations to minority and female contractor associations and other business associations.
 - p. Conduct a review, at least annually, of all supervisors' adherence to and performance under the Contractor's EEO policies and affirmative action obligations.
8. Contractors are encouraged to participate in voluntary associations which assist in fulfilling one or more of their affirmative action obligations (7a through p). The efforts of a contractor association, joint contractor-union, contractor-community, or other similar group of which the contractor is a member and participant, may be asserted as fulfilling any one or more of its obligations under 7a through p of these Specifications provided that the contractor actively participates in the group, makes every effort to assure that the group has a positive impact on the employment of minorities and women in the industry, ensures that the concrete benefits of the program are reflected in the Contractor's minority and female workforce participation, makes a good faith effort to meet its individual goals and timetables, and can provide access to documentation which demonstrates the effectiveness of actions taken on behalf of the Contractor. The obligation to comply, however, is the Contractor's and failure of such a group to fulfill an obligation shall not be a defense for the Contractor's noncompliance.
 9. A single goal for minorities and a separate single goal for women have been established. The Contractor, however, is required to provide equal employment opportunity and to take affirmative action for all minority groups, both male and female, and all women, both minority and non-minority. Consequently, the Contractor may be in violation of the Executive Order if a particular group is employed in a substantially disparate manner (for example, even though the Contractor has achieved its goals for women generally, the Contractor may be in violation of the Executive Order if a specific minority group of women is underutilized).
 10. The Contractor shall not use the goals and timetables or affirmative action standards to discriminate against any person because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

Any Contractor who fails to carry out such sanctions and penalties shall be in violation of these specifications and Executive Order 11246, as amended.

13. The Contractor, in fulfilling its obligations under these specifications, shall implement specific affirmative action steps, at least as extensive as those standards prescribed in paragraph 7 of these specifications, so as to achieve maximum results from its efforts to ensure equal employment opportunity. If the Contractor fails to comply with the requirements of the Executive Order, the implementing regulations, or these specifications, the Director shall proceed in accordance with 41 CFR 60-4.8.
 14. The Contractor shall designate a responsible official to monitor all employment related activity to ensure that the company EEO policy is being carried out, to submit reports relating to the provisions hereof as may be required by the Government and to keep records. Records shall at least include for each employee the name, address, telephone numbers, construction trade, union affiliation if any, employee identification number when assigned, social security number, race, sex, status (e.g., mechanic, apprentice trainee, helper, or laborer), dates of changes in status, hours worked per week in the indicated trade, rate of pay, and locations at which the work was performed. Records shall be maintained in an easily understandable and retrievable form; however, to the degree that existing records satisfy this requirement, contractors shall not be required to maintain separate records.

Nothing herein provided shall be construed as a limitation upon the application of other laws which establish different standards of compliance or upon the application of requirements for the hiring of local or other area residents (e.g., those under the Public Works Employment Act of 1977 and the Community Development Block Grant Program).

Whereas, The City has received an application for a Zoning Map Amendment for 710 Menominee Road, identified as parcel (64-14-31-127-001) from Venture, Inc., and the applicant's petition is for the rezoning of the aforementioned parcel and the redevelopment of the vacant Washington Middle School building; and

Whereas, The Planning Department has reviewed the applicant's rezoning request and the requirements set forth by Section 6.804 of the Zoning Ordinance, and the Planning Department has determined the aforementioned request and proposed intended use of the property complies with the City of Pontiac Zoning Ordinance; and

Whereas, In accordance with the procedures outlined in the Zoning Ordinance, Sections 6.802 as it relates to Zoning Map Amendments, the request has undergone the required: Technical Review, Public Hearing, and Planning Commission Recommendation; and

Whereas, On February 7, 2018, a Public Hearing was held, and in consideration of public opinion, the Planning Commission conditionally approved the zoning amendment request for the eastern portion of the site, and the Planning Commission recommends City Council approve the Zoning Map Amendment request for 710 Menominee Road, approving the change from the current R-1 One Family Dwelling District zoning to R-3 Multi-Family Dwelling District; and

Whereas, The Planning Commission's conditional approval recommendation of PF 18-03 Zoning Map Amendment, is contingent on the lot split of the subject parcel (64-14-31-127-001); and

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the City Council for the City of Pontiac approve the Planning Commission recommendation for the Zoning Map Amendment (PF-18-03) request for 710 Menominee Road, to amend the current zoning from R-1 One Family Dwelling District zoning to R-3 Multi-Family Dwelling District.

Analysis of Petition

The City has received a request from Venture, Inc. to rezone approximately 10.385 acres of land located on the north side of Menominee Road between Chippewa Road on the east and S. Genesee Ave. on the west from R-1 One Family Dwelling District to R-3 Multiple Family Dwelling District. According to the completed Application for Zoning Map Amendment, the applicant proposes to rehabilitate the existing vacant former Washington Middle School into 38-40 senior apartments.

The applicant's proposed use is determined to be a multiple-family apartment building use, and this type of use is permissible in an R-3 Multiple Family Dwelling District. If the zoning map amendment is approved by City Council, the applicant will be required to complete a full site plan review per Section 6.204 to obtain preliminary site plan review.

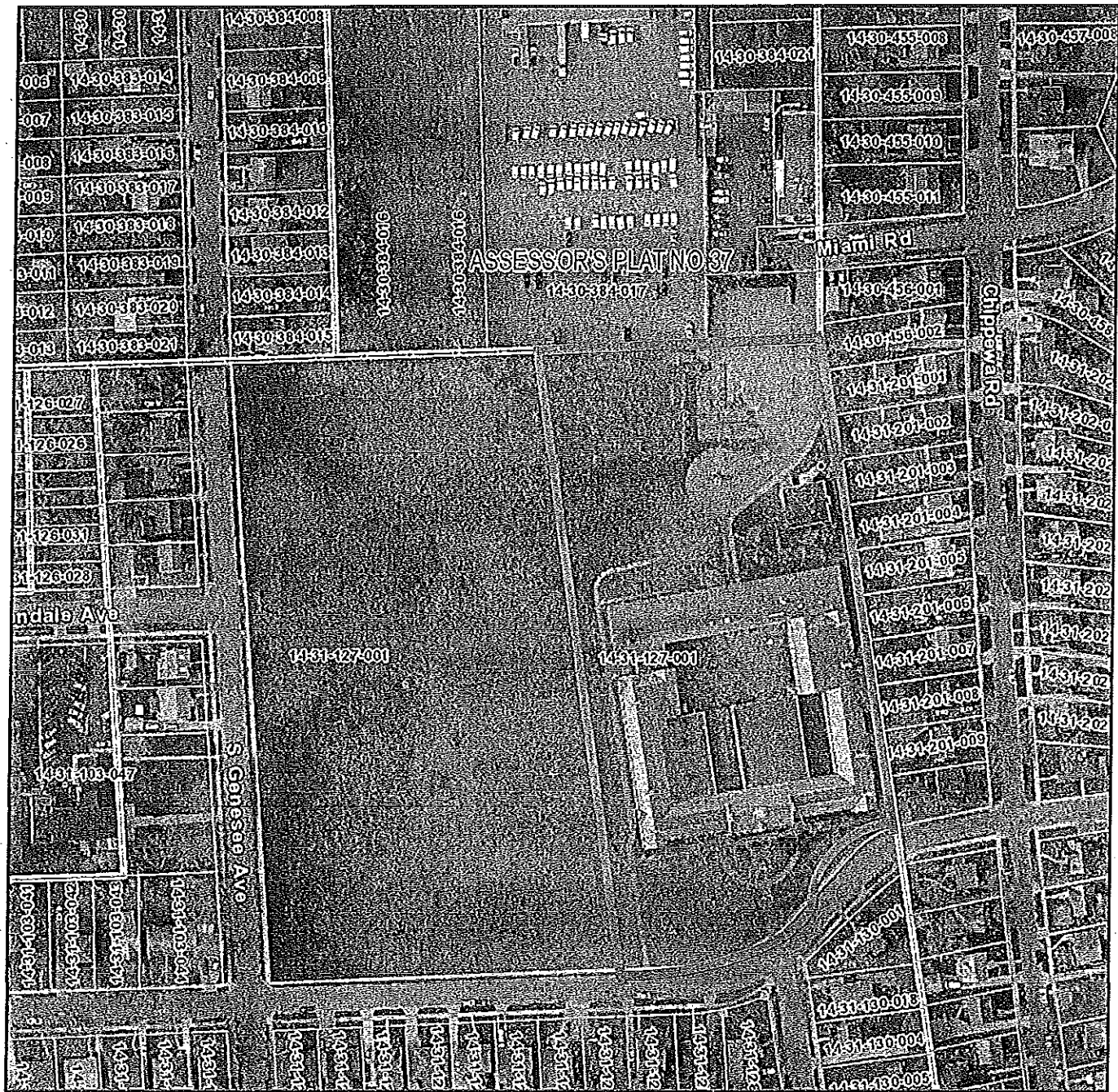
The existing school is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, and it will be listed on the National Register so that the project may take advantage of the Federal Historic Tax Credits. Historic preservation is an acknowledged goal of the City of Pontiac through its local historic district program, and encouraging historic preservation is an important activity for the City. Historic schools have few rehabilitation options, and converting these structures into apartments is one of the few types of reuses that have been replicated widely on a national scale. This project would successfully address this issue of a vacant school building adjacent to the Seminole Hills Historic District.

The subject site is designated as the Entrepreneurial: Residential, Commercial, and Green Future Land Use Category in the Master Plan. This location has been identified in the master planning process as a potential catalyst site that would bring positive reinvestment into the community. This proposed use will bring a new use to a vacant historic building that is currently blighting the adjoining neighborhood.

This rezoning action complies with the requirements found within the Master Plan's Entrepreneurial classification. The district's stated goal is to provide flexibility that encourages the positive reuse of vacant properties in strategic locations around the City. The adaptive reuse of this building is clearly one of the goals of this land use classification. Page 74 of the Master Plan confirms that the redevelopment of the vacant Pontiac School District properties is identified as a key activity for the Economic Development section of the Master Plan. With input from the community, the Planning Commission recommends that the lot split must concurrently occur with the rezoning action. The Planning Commission will be reviewing the lot split request at its March 7, 2018 meeting.

Per the review requirements found in Sec. 6.804 of the Zoning Ordinance, the Planning Commission recommend that the applicant's rezoning request be approved for the eastern portion of the site that is part of the Washington Square development.

Whereas, The Planning Department has reviewed the applicants rezoning request and the requirements set forth by Section 6.804 of the Zoning Ordinance, and the Planning Department has determined the aforementioned request and proposed intended use of the property complies with the City of Pontiac Zoning Ordinance; and

Whereas, In accordance with the procedures outlined in the Zoning Ordinance, Sections 6.802 as it relates to Zoning Map Amendments, the request has undergone the required: Technical Review, Public Hearing, and Planning Commission Recommendation; and

Whereas, On February 7, 2018, a Public Hearing was held, and the Planning Commission recommends City Council approve the Zoning Map Amendment request for 1416 Joslyn Road, approving the change from the current C-4 Suburban Business District zoning to C-3 Corridor Commercial District; and

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the City Council for the City of Pontiac approve the Planning Commission recommendation for the Zoning Map Amendment (PF-17-30) request for 1416 Joslyn Road, to amend the current zoning from C-4 Suburban Business District zoning to C-3 Corridor Commercial District.

Analysis of Petition

The City has received a request from Hope Hospitality and Warming Center to rezone approximately 14,700 square feet of land located on the eastside of Joslyn Road between Walton Boulevard on the north and Columbia Avenue on the south from C-4 Suburban Business District to C-3 Corridor Commercial District.

According to the completed Application for Zoning Map Amendment, the applicant proposes to renovate the existing medical office building into a temporary housing facility for formerly homeless individuals who have been discharged from the hospital while they recover from acute illness, surgery, or injury. There will be onsite 24/7 year-round supervision. The patients will be housed throughout the day and driven to all their appointments, and they will be discharged directly into permanent housing.

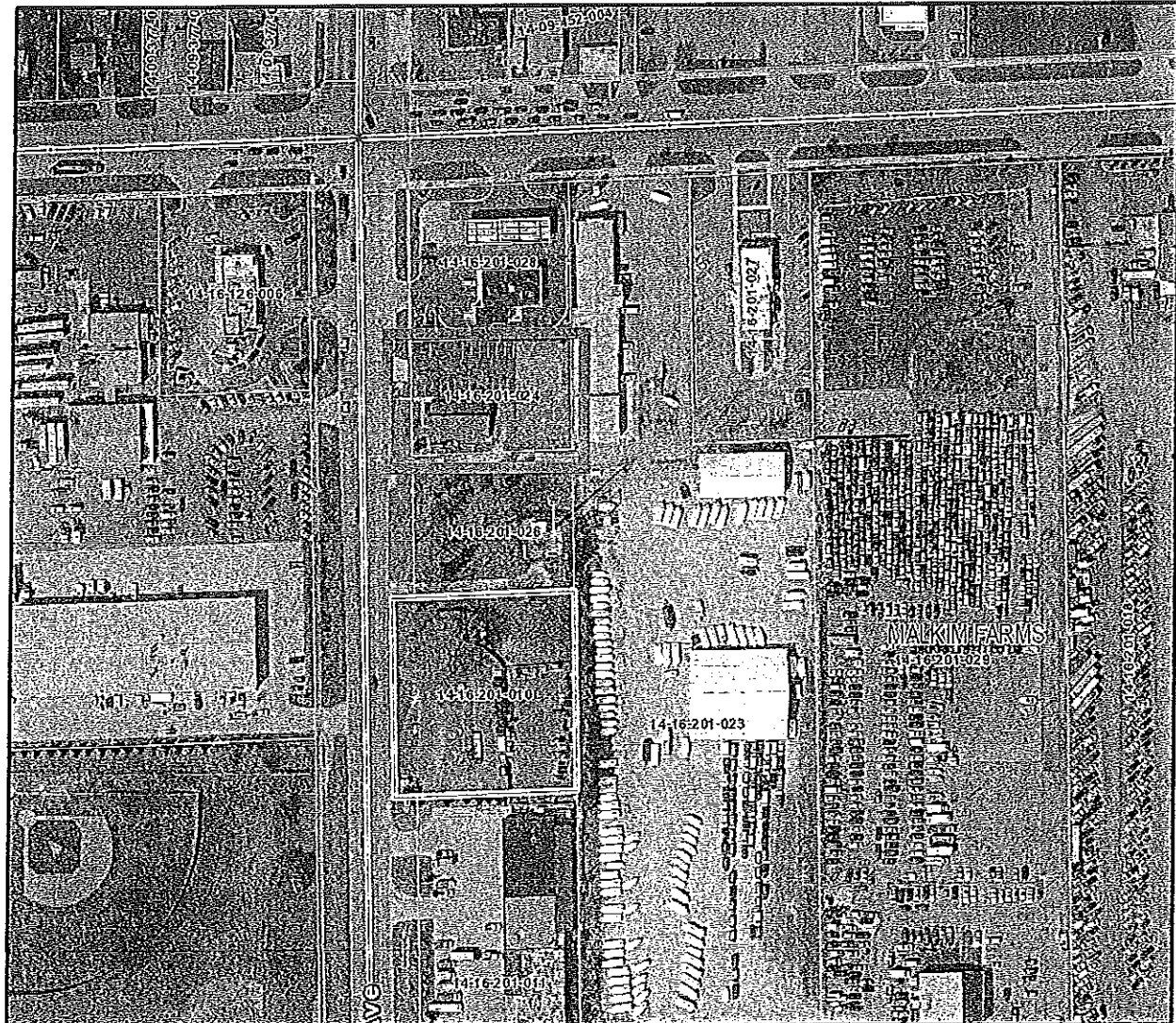
The applicant's proposed use is determined to be a nursing home use, and this type of use is permissible in a C-3 Corridor Commercial District. If the zoning map amendment is approved, the applicant will be required to complete a full site plan review per Section 6.204.

The subject site is located one parcel south of the intersection of Joslyn Road and E. Walton Boulevard. The land use in the surrounding area is a mixture of commercial activities to the north along E. Walton Boulevard, vehicular and boat storage to the east, residential and commercial uses to the south and west of the subject site. Immediately surrounding the subject site, the land was rezoned to C-4 Suburban Business several years ago in the hope that the land would be consolidated into a larger parcel for a larger-scale suburban commercial development. Currently, none of the property has been consolidated to effect this land use change. This rezoning would not preclude this type of development from occurring in the future.

The subject site and surrounding area is designated as the Entrepreneurial: Residential, Commercial, and Green Future Land Use Category in the Master Plan. This location has been identified in the master planning process as a potential catalyst site that would bring positive reinvestment into the community. This proposed use will not affect the site's redevelopment potential with the proposed rezoning.

Per the review requirements found in Sec. 6.804 of the Zoning Ordinance, the Planning Commission recommend that the applicant's rezoning request be approved.

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



Analysis of Special Exemption Permit Request

The City has received a special exemption permit application from Aerostar Holdings Inc. seeking to approve the site for a Specially Designated Merchant (SDM) liquor license at 510 W. Huron Street, a Sunoco Mini Mart. We have reviewed the application, the site plan submitted with the application, and relevant City and State liquor licensing provisions.

The site has been in use as a gas station in the existing form since at least 1997. No alterations to the site or existing building are proposed. Regarding the existing zoning requirements, the current building meets all requirements of the C-3 Corridor Commercial District with the exception of rear setback requirements. However, the building predates the existing zoning ordinance and is classified as a Class C nonconformity.

The applicant has received a liquor license from the State of Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC) on August 3, 2017. Several years ago, the MLCC changed its policy of requiring to receive input from the local municipality prior to the issuance of a liquor license. Now, in many instances, the MLCC does not require the local municipal sign-off prior to license issuance.

Section 10-188 of the City Code prevents that sale of alcoholic beverages within 500 feet of a church or a school. The applicant's site is within 450 feet of Messiah Missionary Baptist Church at 15 Mark Street.

Section 2.515 of the Zoning Ordinance further stipulates that alcohol sales may not be within one mile of another alcohol sales establishment.

Per these two requirements, the applicant's request was reviewed at the February 7, 2018 Planning Commission for his request for a Special Exemption Permit to allow alcohol sales on his premises. The Planning Commission denied the applicant's request.

Per Section 6.302.H, the applicant may appeal the Planning Commission's decision relative the issuance of a Special Exemption Permit to City Council. The Planning Division received the applicant's written appeal within the ten day appeal window.

This application has raised issues relative the processing of liquor licenses in light of the changed policies at the MLCC. The Municipal Code requires City Council to conduct an Annual Review of licenses and allows for the revocation of licenses for cause.

It was the recommendation of Chip Smith that the applicant is in compliance of the Special Exemption Permit requirements; however, the applicant is in violation of the General and Zoning Ordinance requirements relative location from a church and distance requirements. In light of these issues, the Planning Commission denied the application.

We recommend that City Council reestablish the annual review procedures so that the Department of Building Safety and Planning may better regulate these intensive uses.

There would be two possible resolutions from City Council relative this appeal:

- 1) Resolution to grant the Special Exemption Permit appeal of Mr. Rasil Elia of Aerostar Holdings, Inc., or
- 2) Resolution to deny the Special Exemption Permit appeal of Mr. Rasil Elia of Aerostar Holdings, Inc.
